Fees for Regular & Junior

Entry fees in the Open and Junior departments are as follows: single rabbit, fur and meat classes, \$3 each: meat pen, consisting of three animals, \$5.

Arrival / Departure

Open Division Entries

- Arrival: Tuesday, September 10th from 8:00 AM to 7:00 PM
- Departure: Thursday, September 12th at 7:00 PM
- Must be checked out by the Superintendent.

Junior Division Entries

- Arrival Friday: September 6th from 8:00 AM to 7:00 PM
- Departure: Sunday, September 8th at 7:00 PM
- Must be checked out by the Superintendent.

****Absolutely no rabbits will be allowed on grounds except those entered in competition.****

Special Rules - Junior Division

The New Mexico State Fair is a member of the American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc. and will hold its show under the rules of the association.

1. Absolutely no rabbits allowed in the show room unless entered in competition.
2. Entry blanks must be signed by the County Agent or FFA Advisor (Entries without ear numbers, sex or colors will be returned).
3. Entries close August 1 of the current year. **ALL ENTRY INFORMATION AND LINKS WILL BE POSTED ON THE FAIR'S WEBSITE AT:**

Entries must be made in the name of the actual owner. Rabbits must be owned and records kept from May 1st of the current year (Rabbit meat pens must be owned no later than June 30 of the current year). Absolutely no breeding will be allowed in the show room. Substitutions permitted only in class of original entry. Rabbits may not leave the show room until released at the conclusion of the show. Failure to abide by this rule will result in forfeiture of prize money and awards. Superintendent must check out rabbits.

4. Each animal must have a permanent legible earmark in the LEFT ear. Animals having illegible earmarks will be disqualified. The right ear is reserved for the registration number if the animal is registered. Pedigreed rabbits shall be shown in Purebred classes only, including Fur and Meat.
5. Must be an active member in either 4-H or FFA in New Mexico and cannot have shown in any other state other than New Mexico.

Special Rules - Open and Junior

(Rabbit entries without ear numbers, sex or colors will be returned.)

The New Mexico State Fair is a member of the American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc. and will hold its show under the rules of the association.

1. Junior Entry blanks must be signed by the County Agent or FFA Advisor.
2. Junior Exhibitors - see Junior Division General Rules (4-H & FFA).
3. Junior Exhibitors - Rabbits must be owned and records kept as of May 1st. of current year (Rabbit meat pens must be owned no later than June 30 of the current year).
4. Open Exhibitors - read General Rules and Regulations.
5. Absolutely no rabbits allowed in the show room unless entered in competition.
6. Entries for Open and Junior Divisions close August 1 of the current year. **ALL ENTRY INFORMATION AND LINKS WILL BE POSTED ON THE FAIR'S WEBSITE AT:**

7. Entries must be made in the name of the actual owner. Absolutely no breeding will be allowed in the show room. Substitutions permitted only in class of original entry. Rabbits may not leave the show room until released at the conclusion of the show. Failure to follow this rule will cause the exhibitor to forfeit all prize money and awards.
8. Open Division: Daily Gate 6 Parking Pass is \$7 per day. Exhibitor Passes are \$7 per day. The passes are available online or in the Livestock Office.
9. Each animal must have a permanent legible earmark in the LEFT ear. Animals having illegible earmarks will be disqualified. The right ear is reserved for the registration number if the animal is

registered.

10. Exhibitors are required to furnish their own cups for water and feed.
11. Rabbits will be fed, watered and cared for by special qualified watchmen who will be on duty day and night to properly protect animals, but the New Mexico State Fair will not be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur.
12. No person will be permitted to handle exhibits during judging without permission of show officials. Any person interfering with a judge or judging in any way will cause his exhibit to be disqualified.
13. At the discretion of the superintendent or assistant superintendent, animal or animals may be medicated.

****General Rules Governing Entries in this Division Must Be Followed.****

Meat Classes

Must be entered in regular breed classification. Additional entry: \$3 per rabbit - \$5 for Meat Pen Classes

Single Fryer: not over 10 weeks, minimum weight of 3 ½ pounds, maximum weight 5 ½ pounds each.

Single Roaster: must be under six months of age. Minimum weight over 5 ½ pounds, maximum weight 8 pounds.

Single Stewer Rabbits: must be six months of age or over. Minimum weight over 8 pounds.

Meat Pen, Small Fryers: 3 rabbits under 69 days, minimum weight 3 ½ pounds, maximum weight 5 ½ pounds.

(Entry breed classification is not required.)

There MUST be at least three (3) Meat Pens confirmed to show before a Grand Champion will be awarded. The Grand Champion Junior will be awarded \$1,000.

Any ownership manipulation that affects the New Mexico State Fair, or a subsequent livestock show, including the sale of an animal exhibited at the New Mexico State Fair which will be shown at subsequent livestock shows, is considered an unethical practice.

Classes & Awards

Junior exhibitors will use the same classes as the open rabbit department.

The Cavies section is listed in the open livestock section. The Cavy show is an approved show.

- Junior Boars and Sows – up to 4 months, minimum weight 12 oz., maximum weight 22 oz.
- Intermediate Boars and Sows – up to 6 months or weigh over 22 oz. and up to and including 32 oz.
- Senior Boars and Sows – over 32 oz.
- Cavies will be entered in the Breed and Group Classes only.
- Cavy Show is limited to one hundred (100) entries total. Exhibitors must furnish water bottles and feed dishes.
