### Special Rules

- This Division is for hobbyist. Professionals who sell should consider submitting items into a professional department/gallery, see section 428.
- Entries must be the work of the exhibitor only.
- Exhibitor's name on any entry must be concealed, except for professional non-judged.
- Entries must be one of a kind, multiple production items not allowed.
- Pieces must be able to be easily handled by two people.
- Pieces must be ready for display, with all wires, hooks and chains attached appropriately.
- Judges may reject or reclassify entries. Decisions of the judges are final.
- Precautions are taken for the safety of all entries, but in no case, will the New Mexico State Fair, the state of New Mexico, employees, contractors or volunteers be held liable for the loss or damages to any entry while in the Fair's possession. Participants are encouraged to carry their own insurance.
- Participant recognizes that marketing of the Fair and its grounds requires use of photography and video. Participant hereby expressly grants to the Fair the irrevocable, assignable right and license to take, use and publish participant images and work without the need for any other approval. Images and work will not be used for profit.
- Participants are responsible for picking up their own work or provide written authorization for pick-up by another individual.
- Work must be picked up Tuesday, September 22, 2026, from 9:00am – 4:00pm. Any work remaining on the Fairgrounds after this date will be considered abandoned and shall become the property of the NM State Fair to be disposed of at its discretion.
