### **Division Rules**

**\*\*See Junior Division General Livestock Rules\*\***

1. New Mexico Brand Requirements: SHEEP AND GOATS
  - Proof of ownership (NMLB "form 1" inspection certificate) must accompany the animal when traveling, whether in or out of district; this is the assurance that all requirements are met.
  - A NMLB APPROVED fair ear tag provided by the NMLB, a N.M. registered tattoo and a Form 1 inspection issued by the NMLB.
  - Sexually intact sheep and goats must have an official USDA Scrapie tag applied to the ear and/or breed registration tattoo.
  - This rule applies to all species and breeds entered in junior shows.
2. Any animal shown in this department must continuously have been owned and personally cared for by the exhibitor since June 15th of the current year. Breeder names will not be allowed to be seen and the breeder tags must be taped over or removed.
3. Only wethers and doe kids will be exhibited in the doe goat classes.

4. The entry deadline is midnight August 1 of the current year. Entries will only be accepted on-line through the New Mexico State Fair website. The Entry fee is \$15.00 per goat. The entry fee for the showmanship class is \$5.00. Late Entry Fee: Late entries will be accepted until August 10 of the current year with a late fee of \$10 per animal. **ALL ENTRIES WILL BE ENTERED & PAID ONLINE**

## 5. Health Requirements & Inspection Procedure:

All junior wether does will be checked by the New Mexico State Fair Vet or a New Mexico State Fair Livestock Management Official

- a. The fair and show management will provide trained personnel with capability of sampling skin lesions and conducting a microscopic examination to determine the presence of ringworm.
  - b. Goats with active ringworm lesions will be denied entrance to the fairgrounds. However, goats hauled on same trailer will be allowed to show.
  - c. Goats must be free of external parasites, scabies, sore mouth, foot rot and other contagious diseases or will not be allowed to show.
6. Wether Does will be classified, brand inspected and inspected by the veterinarian. Exhibitors will declare their own show weights. **Weights will be due online by 1:00 p.m.** on Saturday, September 10th and must be submitted by all Junior Market goat exhibitors. This will become the official weight for that animal. Declared weights for wether does in a range from 55 pounds and up. At judging the judge will pick the Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Wether Doe. Weights must correspond to a declared weight within 5 lbs. plus or minus. The wether does will then be placed. Any wether doe that does not meet the weight tolerance will be disqualified. (Example: declared weight is 100 lbs. – goat cannot weigh over 105 lbs.).
  7. Absolutely NO dressing (such as oil, paint, powder, adhesive, etc.) other than water may be used on junior wether does. Any goat with dressing other than water will be immediately removed from the ring and will not be allowed to compete for premiums.
  8. Violators of this rule may be disqualified from the show by the superintendent or livestock manager.

## 1. YQCA Certification

Any exhibitor entering a Junior Market Show at the New Mexico State Fair is required to take the YQCA test and receive their YQCA Certificate of Completion.

The YQCA, otherwise known as the YOUTH FOR QUALITY CARE OF ANIMALS, is a multi species assurance program. Visit: <https://yqcaprogram.org/> to obtain your certification if you have not already done so.
