Rules of the Contest

- 1. Contestants are responsible for knowing the rules of the contest. Entries that do not meet Requirements will be eliminated prior to or during judging. <u>Read the following rules carefully.</u>
- 2. The Junior Baking contest is open to children 17 years of age and younger. Each category has a separate class for children 9 and under.
- 3. No store-bought and/or pre-made mixes allowed.
- 4. Only three (3) entries per exhibitor and each entry must be in a different class.
- 5. Recipes need to be submitted with every entry and must use King Arthur Flour. Please attach a proof of purchase, such as a receipt or logo cut from the product container itself, to the recipe. Recipes should exactly match the manners in which the entries were prepared. DO NOT put names, addresses, or phone numbers on recipes. However, if you are a teacher and your class is participating, please include the name of your school on each recipe. Also, recipes submitted become the property of the New Mexico State Fair with all publication rights.
- 6. All entries are judged against the ideal standard for their type, not simply against each other. Judging will be open to the public starting at 1:30 PM. Throughout the contest winners will be announced by name. Winning entries will be kept on display until the end of the Fair. Non-winners must be retrieved by 5:00 PM on the day of the contest.
- 7. **Special note for entries made during State Fair hours:** Exhibitors may drive through Gate #4 to the Creative/Home Arts Building between 8:00 AM and 9:00 AM to unload and enter exhibits. After 9:00 AM exhibitors must park in Lot #4 and walk entries to the Creative/Home Arts Building. There is absolutely NO driving allowed on Main Street

after 9:00 AM. After entries have been placed, if exhibitors intend to remain on the Fairgrounds, vehicles must be moved to parking Lots #1or #8. There are additional awards for the Junior Baking Contest. See the Awards listed at the end of this section.

- 8. Entries are judged against the ideal standard for their type, not simply against each other.
- 9. In order to safeguard against loss in this department, no one, with the exception of the judge and the superintendent, will be permitted to handle any article once put in place. Every precaution will be taken for the safety of all entries but in no case will the New Mexico State Fair or State of New Mexico be responsible for loss or damages to any entry when it is in the Fair's possession.
- 10. Exhibitor recognizes that marketing of the Fair and its grounds requires use of photography and video. Exhibitor hereby expressly grants to the Fair the irrevocable, assignable right and license to take, use and publish exhibitor images and property without the need for any other approval. Exhibitor also releases the Fair, its agents or assigns, from all claims related to the licenses that have been granted in this release.
- 11. As a participant, volunteer, or attendee, you recognize that your participation, involvement and/or attendance at any Fair event or activity includes possible exposure to and illness from infectious diseases including but not limited to COVID-19. While particular rules and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious illness and death does exist and that you knowingly and freely assume all such risks related to illness and infectious diseases, such as COVID-19, even if arising from the negligence or fault of the Released Parties.

Cookies

Classes 1-21

Six (6) must be included for each entry with exception being Gingerbread People which only requires three (3) cookies. Raisins or nuts are acceptable.

Quick Breads

Classes 22-32

Except when noted, quick breads must be baked in loaf pan, no smaller than 8 inches. Loaves are to be entered in sturdy foil covered cardboard 1inch larger and not to exceed 2 inches larger than entry. Muffins, biscuits and tortillas will be entered on disposable plates.

- 23. Biscuit Four (4) must be entered
- 24. Coffee Cake

Yeast Breads

Classes 33-40

Each bread loaf or coffee cake should be entered on a sturdy, foil covered cardboard, 1 inch larger and not to exceed 2 inch larger than entry. Rolls should be on disposable plates.

- 33. Breakfast Rolls, Sweet (Six (6) must be entered)
- 34. Cloverleaf Rolls (Six (6) must be entered)
- 35. Coffee Cake (includes all sweet yeast breads)
- 36. Crescent Rolls (Six (6) must be entered)
- 37. Gluten Free Any Flavor
- 38. White Loaf Traditional

- 39. Whole Wheat Loaf Traditional
- 40. Yeast Bread any made by 9 years old or younger

a. Rolls (six (6) must be entered)

b. Yeast Bread – any type

Cakes

Classes 41-57

All cakes should be baked in rounds. No whipped cream frosting or whipped cream filling is allowed. However, other fillings, such as fruit, are accepted. Entries must be submitted on bakery cardboard or sturdy, foil –covered cardboard 1-inch and not to exceed 2-inchs larger than cake.

Layer, Iced Cake

Baked in rounds and entered in 2 or more layers. Layers may be made from single-layered cakes cut horizontally.

Un-Iced Cake

Baked in a tube, Bundt or Loaf pan no smaller than 8 inches without drizzle, glaze, or icing. Entered on bakery cardboard or sturdy, foil – covered 1 inch and not to exceed 2-inches larger than cake.
