## **Tanya Tucker Announced for 2026 New Mexico State Fair**

*Tanya Tucker is scheduled for Friday, Sept. 18*

New Mexico State Fair officials announced the addition of Country Music Hall of Fame inductee Tanya Tucker to the 2026 New Mexico State Fair rodeo-concert lineup. Tanya Tucker will take the stage on Friday, Sept. 18, following the Chevron PRCA rodeo.

Tanya burst onto the scene at just 13 years old with her first hit "Delta Dawn". Since then, she has amassed 23 Top-40 albums, 56 Top 40 singles, and 10 No. 1 hits on the Billboard country music charts.

Tanya's career is decorated with numerous accolades, including two CMAs, two ACMs, three CMT awards, and two GRAMMY Awards for Best Country Album (*While I'm Livin'*) and Best Country Song (*Bring My Flowers Now*).
