Adult / Open

Youth

Youth entry fee for each animal is \$15. All animals shown in youth competition must be entered in the adult/open qualifying show. All youth entries, fees and applications will be processed through the TLBNM youth sponsor (not NM State Fair) and MUST be postmarked no later than August 1 of the current year. Eligibility & Rules

- Entries must be entered online by the entry deadline of August 1 of the current year. Late entries will not be accepted after the late entry deadline of August 10 of the current year. ALL ENTRIES WILL BE ENTERED & PAID ONLINE
- 2. Cattle can be double registered but must present their registration to the TLBAA.
- 3. The owner of the cattle entered in a qualifying show must be a member in good standing of the TLBAA.
- 4. All cattle must be 120 days of age to exhibit at any show.
- 5. The section on grooming of animals will be strictly adhered to.
- 6. Any female over 30 months of age must have either a nursing Texas Longhorn calf at side or the results of a pregnancy test listed on the health certificate. ***This applies to any female born before April of the previous year.***
- 7. Females will be shown in one of two divisions: free or haltered. Produce of Dam and Get of Sire classes will be shown at halter. NURSING calves (205 days or less) may be shown with its dam at the owner's discretion. These calves must be currently nursing on a daily basis. Calves that have been weaned at home are not eligible to be shown at the side. Calves shown with dams must be eligible for registration in the TLBAA Texas Longhorn registry (no crossbred calves).
- 8. All animals are eligible for either Haltered or Non-Haltered, but NOT BOTH.
- 9. Any animal shown in any Halter class will not be issued a stall.

10. A dress code will be enforced at the show:

Western attire, long sleeve shirt with collar and cuffs. Western boots and western jeans are to be worn while in the ring. Western hats may be worn. Violators of this rule will be disqualified upon the discretion of the show chair, show secretary, and the TLBNM board of directors.

No ball caps will be allowed in the show ring at any point during the show, including during photographs and the pee wee show.

11. All Bulls will be shown at halter WITH NOSE LEAD. Bulls 12 months of age and older must be shown with a permanent nose ring and nose lead. Neck ties or neck straps must be used on all

bulls over 12 months when secured in a stall.

- 12. No pending registrations will be accepted at time of show date. If the animal is pending at the time of entry, the animal must have a copy of its registration certificate shown to the beef superintendent at check in and before it will be allowed into the show ring. Please send in a copy of your registration. You <u>must</u> have a copy of your registration certificate at the time of check in.
- 13. Unmanageable Animals: All show entries are expected to be manageable. Should an animal become unmanageable, the show management shall have the right and responsibility to remove such animal from the competition, and all entry and stalling fees shall be forfeited.
- 14. All animals MUST be exhibited in the Open Texas Longhorn Show on Saturday, September 17, 2022
- 15. The New Mexico State Fair will post all travel requirements for animals and those must be met at time of check in.

Premier Youth Exhibitor

Determined by the youth (up to and including age 18) competing in existing halter classes who exhibits the most animals with the most points. Points are determined as follows: 1 point for each entry plus 4 points for any of those entries who placed 1st, 3 points for 2nd place; 2 points for 3rd place and 1 point for 4th. Award to be announced.

In the event of a tie in the Premier Youth category, points for champions will be included as follows: 4 for Grand Champion and 3 for Reserve Grand Champion; 2 for Champion; 1 for Reserve Champion.

1st Place Only......Rosette & \$100
