General Rules for Honey

<u>Please contact superintendent with entry questions and to</u> <u>clarify requirements!</u>

- Limit one entry per class per exhibitor.
- 17 & Under enter youth division.
- Exhibitors first 25 entries are subject to a \$1 fee per entry. After 25 entries, there are no additional fees. Entry fees are charged to help offset the increased premiums. (Example: 2 entries equal \$2, \$25 entries equal \$25 while 45 entries equal \$25)
- Only pre-enter classes you know you have an entry for. If you are unsure, please wait and enter when dropping off all entries.

EXTRACTED HONEY Division 03A

- Two samples constitute an entry.
- Exhibited honey may be produced in 2021 or 2022.
- Clear glass containers only. No labels, stickers, or markings.
- Liquid Honey (16 oz Queenline-style jars only)
- Exhibitors may have assistance with selecting the appropriate color class when entries are delivered.
- Creamed Honey (8 oz Wide mouth clear glass jars only)

What the Judges look for in Extracted Honey

- Density (moisture content)
- Absence of crystals, bubbles, and foam
- Cleanliness (No lint, dust, wax, bee parts, or foreign objects)
- Flavor & Aroma (No burnt or objectionable taste from honey processing or management of bees)

- Color (light, amber, or dark)
- Container appearance, exterior cleanliness, and accuracy of filling to the same level.

HONEY EXTRACTING FRAMES Division 03B

- One frame of capped honey constitues an entry.
- Each entry must be wrapped with clear plastic wrap (e.g., Saran Wrap, etc.) to prevent honey leakage.
- Please provide frame stand to display and protect each frame entered.

What the Judges look for in Honey Extracting Frames

- Uniformity of appearance of honey & wax
- Absence of uncapped cells
- Uniformity of color
- Absence of watery cappings
- Absence of granulation & pollen
- Cleanliness of the exterior frame sections & cappings

- Constraints on size/dimensions may be imposed by superintendent if space is limited.

- Attractiveness and professional appearance
- Time and effort of exhibitor

- Container must be covered with clear plastic wrap (e.g. saran wrap, etc.)
- A list of contents must be attached to the outside of the container.
- Container must include at least one item from a North Idaho Beekeepers hive. (Identify Beekeeper if other than exhibitor)
- Contents of Gift Package may include: Items that promote the use of hive products such as honey, wax, wax products, lotion, soap, lip balms, ect and/or beekeeping tools or other items related to beekeeping. "Bee Creative"
- <u>Extra points</u>: Include decorations related to the 2022 Fair theme: Salute to a Century!

What the Judges look for in Gift Package

- Originality
- Neatness of workmanship
- Variety of components & contents
- Quality of content
- Extra points for use of the fair theme in gift package design

Special Award sponsored by Kelly McSheehy. First place will receive \$10 cash prize and rosette. Second place \$6 and Third \$4. If only one entry, the winner takes all \$20 prize award. Adult and youth entries will be considered for this award.
