General Rules for Needlecrafting

- Entries must be the work of the exhibitor, completed since September 2022.
- Limit <u>one</u> entry per class per exhibitor
- Entry is free if pre-entered online or by form in the Fair office by 5pm, August 4. Exhibits registered during entry are subject to a \$1 fee per entry.
- 17 & Under enter youth divisions 12D, 12E, and 12F.
- All articles competing for premiums must be completed. Incomplete entries will not be judged.
- Items made with plastic canvas must be entered in Department 13-General Crafts.
- No awards will be allowed for articles entered which have been purchased, received as a gift, or borrowed.
- Where there is no competition, or article has been incorrectly entered, judges may award first, second, third or nothing, according to the merits of the entry. Judges shall not award prizes to unworthy entries.
- The judges reserve the option to withhold ribbons and awards in a class where there is no deserving entry.

Special Awards

Spokane Falls Needlework Guild

The Spokane Falls Needlework Guild will award one \$20 award and a special ribbon for excellence in the execution of needlework. The winner will be determined based on work on construction, use of color and design. Prize money is mailed after the fair concludes.

What the Judge looks for in Needlecrafting

• OVERALL APPEARANCE: All needlework will be judged with regard to beauty, degree of perfection, amount of work and suitability for the purpose for which it is intended. Entry must be neat, clean, properly blocked, finished appropriate to pattern & function (frame, pillow blocking, etc.). If an entry is soiled or there are mistakes in the pattern, it could be disqualified by the judges.

- SUITABILITY OF DESIGN, COLOR, THREAD/YARN: Choice & color of thread or yarn, canvas or fabric type, appropriate to pattern & function. Color selection & quality of yarn will NOT be judged.
- WORKMANSHIP: Stitches made correctly, tension even (no distortion of hole & fabric), stitches smooth & flat (no twisted threads), backstitching straight & even, no visible carry-overs from reverse side.
