General Rules for Draft Horse Show

- Entries must be in by August 4. Contact Superintendents for entry form.
- Performance classes shown with clean harness in good repair.
- Junior and Senior driving judged on driving ability only. Equipment not to count.
- Classes 01, 02, 03, 04, 05 and 06 must have an assistant driver.
- Have a "header" available in all classes.
- Horses stabled in Building 15 are by invitation only and must be in the barn by 11 am Wednesday, August 23. Horses cannot leave the grounds before 4 pm on Sunday, August 27 unless permission to do so is granted by Fair Manager.

PERFORMANCE

CLASS

- 01 4-Up Driving Will drive a pattern.
- 02 Team driving, any gender or age driver. Will drive a pattern.
- 03 Team driving, Junior age 14-18. Must have an adult as an assistant. Expect a pattern!
- 04 Team driving, Junior ages 13 and under. Must have an adult as an assistant. Rail work, stop and back.
- 05 Peewee, 5-8 years old.
- 06 Single Horse, Youth driver, age 18 and under. Must have an adult as an assistant. Rail work, stop and back.
- 07 Ladies Single Horse, pleasure horse

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

- Junior showman must be 17 years or younger on show day of the current year.
- Entrants must braid mane, tail and show the animal themselves; all to be done in the show ring.
- No one may help them other than holding the horse during braiding.
