ADGA Show Rules and Regulations:

- All entries must include full name, address, and telephone number of exhibitor, as well as full registered name of animal.
- All exhibitors must enter the livestock check-in point off Dalton Ave.
- Registration papers need to be checked by the Superintendent to show.
- We would like to encourage all exhibitors to wear white while showing animals.
- Base date for age classes is the first date of show.
- All goats will be clinically inspected by authorized personnel on entering fairgrounds. Goats exhibiting symptoms of Caseous Lymphadenitis (CL), Caprine Arthritis Encephalitis (CAE) or other contagious or infectious diseases, will be asked to leave.
- All animals shown in group classes must have been shown in their regular individual age class. Animals cannot cross divisions for group classes
- This is an official A.D.G.A. sanctioned show and their rules shall govern.
- AOP-all other purebreds include: Sannens, Sables, Toggenburgs, Guernseys.

\$5 per showmanship class entry fee

\$3 per group class entry fee

01 Junior Kid, born after April 1, 2025

02 Intermediate Kid, born March, 2025

03 Senior Kid, born January – February, 2025

04 Junior Yearling, born June 2024 – December 31, 2024

05 Dry Yearling, 12 months and under 24 (never freshened)

06 Junior Get of Sire – Three (3) or more does never to have freshened, produce of same sire, sire must be named, and exhibitor need not own all.

07 Jr. Breeders Trio – Three (3) Junior Does bred and owned by exhibitor

08 Future Herd – to consist of Four (4) Junior Does, no more than Two (2) Dry Yearlings, must all be owned by Exhibitor. One entry per exhibitor.

CLASS

- 15 Get of Sire – to consist of Three (3) Does in milk, one Sire. The exhibitor need not own all. Sire must be named, each exhibitor limited to one entry sired by the same Buck.
- 16 Produce of Dam – to consist of Two (2) Does any age, One (1) to be in milk, produce of the same Doe, Dam must be named, exhibitor need not own all.
- 17 Dam and daughter – One (1) or more, exhibitor's choice, Dam must be named.
- 18 Three generation females (or more, exhibitor's choice) – to consist of Three (3) Does any age.
- 19 Senior Breeders Trio – Three (3) Does in milk, bred and owned by exhibitor. One (1) entry per exhibitor only.
- 20 Dairy Herd – to consist of Four (4) Does in milk owned by the exhibitor. One (1) entry per exhibitor only.
- 21 Exhibitor's Herd – to consist of Two (2) Senior Does and Two 2 Junior Does, all owned by exhibitor. One (1) entry per exhibitor only.
