



## Team Fitting Contest (Beef)

The main objective of the North Idaho State Fair Team Beef Fitting contest is to encourage team participation for the preparation of an animal for the showing. It's important for our youth to learn to lean onto each other for help and guidance and to know how to transfer information individuals have learned from other mentors along the way.

### RULES

1. All contestants must be Exhibitors of the Youth Stock Show & Sale at the North Idaho State Fair.
2. The teams will consist of three members:
  - 1 Junior (8-10)
  - 1 Intermediate (11-13)
  - 1 Senior (14-18)

\* All ages are as of Jan. 1 of the current year
3. Team members may be substituted accordingly: a Junior may substitute for an Intermediate or senior, or an Intermediate may substitute for a senior. Seniors may not substitute for another age division.
4. Each team must provide its own animal for the contest. All supplies needed (trim chute, blower, clippers, adhesive, etc.) must be provided by the team and set up before the start of the competition.
5. Each animal may be fogged at the Judge's discretion before the contest begins.
6. During the fitting time, teams are expected to work independently amongst themselves without outside help or coaching. **NO OUTSIDE ASSISTANCE.**
7. Each team will be allowed 30 minutes to fit their animal.
8. When time is up, one team member will parade their animal before the judges. The judges will make comments and announce the winners.
