- 1-1 Approach & catch horse safely
- 1-2 Properly halter the horse
- 1-3 Lead, turn, & back horse safely & correctly
- 1-4 Lead a horse into & out of a stall
- 1-5 Practice safety rules when turning a horse loose
- 1-6 Safely tie horse (correct level, length, location)
- 1-7 Demonstrate simple grooming
- 1-8 Pick up feet & clean properly
- 1-9 Bridle horse- check fit & make adjustments
- 1-10 Saddle horse- check fit & make adjustments
- 1-11 Demonstrate safely around the horse while handling

Riding - to be ridden one or two handed as correct to & discipline

- 1-12 Mount & dismount properly (may use block)
- 1-13 Describe & discuss safely riding in a group
- 1-14 Use proper, basic seat, leg, body position with balance
- 1-15 Proper use of reins; hand position & action

At a walk with control & proper position:

- 1-16 start & stop (gradual & balanced)
- 1-17 check & release (demonstrating control of horse)
- 1-18 turn while walking & walk both directions
- 1-19 ride a circle both directions & do a figure 8

At a jog/trot with control & proper position:

- 1-20 start & stop (gradual & balanced)
- 1-21 check & release (Demonstrating control of horse)
- 1-22 turn while jogging/trotting both directions

- 1-23 ride a circle both directions & do a figure 8

At a canter/lope with control & proper position:

- 1-24 start & stop (gradual & balanced)
- 1-25 check & release (Demonstrating control of horse)
- 1-26 turn while jogging/trotting both directions
- 1-27 ride a circle both directions & do a figure 8
- 1-28 Drop & regain stirrups at a halt
- 1-29 One rein stop
- 1-30 Equipment, clothing, helmet (condition, fit, suitability)
- 1-31 Overall attitude & confidence
