## *Junior Poultry – Department B07*

---

- **Exhibitors should not register the same birds in both Junior and Open Fair.**

**All exhibitors are expected to be familiar with and follow all expectations covered at the beginning of this guide: Topics include:**

1. Exhibit Guide: Use only this year's guide. Follow the schedule listed on page 1.
2. Method of Registration:
  - online at <http://nwsfa.fairwire.com>
  - Payment is required to complete registration.
  - A registration worksheet with fee details is available on the website.
  - Premise ID, YQCA and other required paperwork may be collected as part of the registration process.
  - By registering to exhibit at the Fair you authorize the use of your image (photo, audio, or video) for NWSF advertising and marketing.

5. Registration: Changes, Additions, Substitutions and Refunds.
6. Exhibit Arrival / Drop-Off:
  - All health or DATCP required paperwork must be presented to the Department Leaders prior to unloading any animal. Purebred animals may be asked to show pedigree papers.
  - Display a printed information card over each stall or pen used for your animals. Some items which fairgoers may want to know include the name, breed, and age of each animal.
7. Judging: DATCP allows classes with low entry numbers to be merged into an 'any other' class at the time of judging. And for large classes to be split into heats. The decision of the certified judge is final.

**Items specific to this department exhibitors agree to:**

- A. A charge of \$1.00 per head is required. This fee also determines the number of animals eligible for cages and show space.
- B. Exhibitors must be members of an approved youth organization from Chippewa County and must be at least eight (8) years of age and under twenty (20) years of age as of January 1 of the current year.
- C. Proof of ownership must be provided upon request.
- D. Health paperwork is required for this species. Poultry and waterfowl need ONE of the following:
  - For eggs and birds of all ages, documentation that the flock of origin is either a Wisconsin Tested Flock and has tested negative for pullorum-typhoid and for turkeys Mycoplasma gallisepticum, Wisconsin Associate Flock, or an NPIP flock.

  - For sexually mature birds (turkeys over 6 months, all other birds over 4 months) that do not qualify as part of a flock status, individual tests within 90 days before arrival at the show. These birds also need

wing or leg band identification (ID). All birds must test negative for pullorum-typhoid, and turkeys must test negative for Mycoplasma gallisepticum.

- Eggs and sexually immature birds are not eligible for individual testing and cannot be shown unless they originate from an enrolled NPIP, NPIP affiliate, Wisconsin Tested, or Wisconsin Associate flock.
- Flock of origin means the flock in which the birds currently reside.

- E. Showmanship class must be entered during registration.
- F. Exhibitors must provide a valid YQCA certificate number during registration and submit a printed or electronic copy to the fair office by the registration deadline.
- G. Exhibitors must respect decisions of Rural Leadership regarding blue-ribbon Junior Fair exhibitors being permitted to carry over to the Open Class for ribbon-only participation, provided Department Leaders approve and space allows.
- H. Exhibitors are responsible for providing all necessary items for the care and feeding of their animals.
- I. Exhibits may be set up only after plastic has been placed on tables beneath poultry cages.
- J. Shavings may be used for bedding; hay or straw is not permitted.
- K. Exhibitors are expected to assist with cleaning and cage removal following the exhibition.

## Age Definitions

- All cockerel, pullet, and waterfowl entries must be hatched on or after January 1 in the exhibit year and are referred to as young birds.
- Hens must be hatched prior to January 1 of the exhibit year and referred to as old birds.
