### Open Draft Horses – Department A06

---

By registering for the NWSF you are committing to be on-site for 3 days. Draft horses must arrive by 2pm on Friday. Shows take place on Saturday and Sunday. Animals may leave after 4pm on Sunday.

All exhibitors are expected to be familiar with and follow all expectations covered at the beginning of this guide: Topics include:

1. **Exhibit Guide: Use only this year's guide. Follow the schedule listed on page 1.**
2. **Method of Registration:**
  - online at <http://nwsfa.fairwire.com>
  - Payment is required to complete registration.
  - A registration worksheet with fee details is available on the website.
  - Premise ID, YQCA and other required paperwork may be collected as part of the registration process.
  - By registering to exhibit at the Fair you authorize the use of your image (photo, audio, or video) for NWSF advertising and marketing.

6. **Exhibit Arrival / Drop-Off:**
  - **All health or DATCP required paperwork must be presented to the Department Leaders prior to unloading any animal.** Purebred animals may be asked to show registration papers.
  - Display a printed information card over each stall or pen used for your animals. Some items which fair-goers may want to know include the name, breed, and age of each animal.
7. **Judging: DATCP allows classes with low entry numbers to be merged into an 'any other' class at the time of judging. And for large classes to be split into heats. The decision of the certified judge is final.**

**Items specific to this department exhibitors agree to:**

- A. **Every time an animal enters the arena in the Hitch Division an appearance payout of \$10 will be added.**
- B. Pay a charge per stall (per head). This fee also determines the number of animals eligible for stalling assignments. Exhibitors will receive one season pass per animal registered, up to a maximum of six; the number of passes needed must be entered during online registration. **Refer to the registration worksheet for detailed pricing for box, tie, or tack stalls.** Department Leaders will determine the availability of tack stall space after registration closes, and verification will be sent at that time. If a tack stall is not available, the fee will be refunded at the end of the fair.
- C. During registration, provide the main contact person's first and last name and the farm name.
- D. Reserve a campsite if camping in a tack trailer or camper. Livestock camping reservation forms are available online or at the fair office. Completed paper forms and payment must be delivered to the office. Campsites are issued on a first-come, first-served basis. Information regarding the type of vehicle, trailer length, and related details must be included on the camping form. The goal is to have all trailers located off-site.

- E. Provide records showing a negative Coggins test for each animal used in the show. Health forms should be provided to Department Leaders before unloading. Only submit paperwork for horses entered in this exhibit. General health rules apply, and any horse found to be infected with a contagious or infectious disease may be ordered removed from the fairgrounds at any time during the fair.
- F. Provide proof of ownership upon request. All animals must be the legal property of the exhibitor as of July 1 of the fair year.
- G. Acknowledge and comply with the following rules: No more than two prizes may be awarded to any exhibitor in a single class. All youth under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult in all Hitch Classes. Youth must be at least eight years old as of January 1 of the show year to participate in this department.
- H. Abide by arrival and release times. Participants must enter through the East Gate and check in at the Coliseum Office upon arrival, using State Street to North Street (next to the cemetery) to access the grounds. Departure is permitted after 4:00 p.m. on Sunday. Order of release will be determined by distance to travel and under the direction of the Department Leaders. Traffic considerations play a significant role in arrival scheduling; exhibitors must adhere to designated arrival times for the safety of animals and visitors.

If unable to arrive before 2:00 p.m. on Friday, exhibitors must contact the Department Leaders for instructions on entering the grounds between midnight and 7:00 a.m. on Saturday. Department Leaders are Tammy E., 715-651-7837, belgians12@yahoo.com, or Joe B., 715-577-3688, JLBohlinger@yahoo.com.
