 - Payment is required to complete registration.

 - Premise ID, YQCA and other required paperwork may be collected as part of the registration process.
 - By registering to exhibit at the Fair you authorize the use of your image (photo, audio, or video) for NWSF advertising and marketing.

 - **All health or DATCP required paperwork must be presented to the Department Leaders prior to unloading any animal.** Purebred animals may be asked to show registration papers.
 - Display a printed information card over each stall or pen used for your animals. Some items which fair-goers may want to know include the name, breed, and age of each animal.
7. **Judging: DATCP allows classes with low entry numbers to be merged into an 'any other' class at the time of judging. And for large classes to be split into heats. The decision of the certified judge is final.**

Items specific to this department exhibitors agree to:

- A. A charge of \$10 per head is required. This fee also determines the number of animals eligible for stalling assignments.
- B. Exhibitors must be Wisconsin residents.
- C. Proof of ownership must be provided upon request.
- D. Only one animal per halter class may be entered, except in group classes. Animal age will be determined by the show date.
- E. Each animal may only earn two premiums, one for exhibition and one for performance. Any other entries will be for ribbon only.
- F. Exhibitors are responsible for providing their own animal feed and bedding.
- G. Proof of registration with the International Llama Registry must be provided upon request.
- H. Llamas must be dewormed within seven (7) days prior to the show.
- I. Each animal may earn two premiums: one for exhibition and one for performance.
- J. Exhibitors agree to accept the decisions of the Department Leaders and the judge if a llama is removed from the show for disruptive behavior.
