BARN REPLACEMENT PROJECT

April 9, 2019, was a sad day as our Show Barn/Coliseum (Red Barn) had to be taken down due to structural concerns. After 130 years of service a portion of the roof collapsed rendering the building unsafe. We will never forget the memories and history of the Red Barn, and now we must replace it and the remaining animal barns that have served the Fairgrounds for over 100 years.

Due to cost savings, excavation for utilities/storm water, and building/environmental codes, the Fair Board is addressing our animal barn area to sustain animal exposition for generations to come. Below you will see renditions of our Barn Replacement Project that consists of two cattle barns, a new Coliseum (heated and air conditioned), small animal barn, and a FEMA designed shower/restroom/safe room structure to meet current and future needs of the Fair and other events to be held at the Northern Wisconsin State Fairgrounds.

This project will provide youth education in agriculture for the next 75 – 100 years and we need your financial help to complete it.
