



# HORSE ARENA RELOCATION



The Horse Arena at the Northern Wisconsin State Fairgrounds is the practice grounds for the award-winning Chi-Hi Equestrian Club, the Chippewa County 4-H Horse Program, and draft horse exhibitions at the Northern Wisconsin State Fair.

The Horse Arena Relocation Project will address the safety needs of horses, exhibitors, and spectators crossing a roadway to the show arena. The wooden arena, gates, and soil are not suitable for multiple competition events and needs replacement. The new location will address safety, maintenance, watering, lighting, and enhanced viewing for multiple events throughout the year. The project will cost an estimated \$110,000 of which 50% has already been committed.

Naming rights are available for the arena, or you can donate a Fencepost (\$250) or Horseshoe (\$500) in support of this project. Donations will be listed on a donation board for all to recognize.
