#### BUDGET OVERVIEW

## Marketing Activities \$332,101

<u>U.S. Wheat Associates</u> – Development of overseas markets through buyer assistance and influencing of trade policy.

USW Special Projects—OWC also funds special projects through USW that focus on SW market development. Projects include a SW Blending Consultant in Latin America and Sponsorship of the Latin American Buyers Conference.

#### Wheat Marketing Center -

Provides technical expertise on wheat quality and development of new products for domestic and overseas customers.

Crop Quality Survey – The Tristate Commissions work with USW and WMC to gather and compile quality data on PNW SW to be published and provided to customers.

<u>PNW SW Marketing Plan</u> – A cooperative effort by the PNW Wheat Commissions to provide regional crop quality data to customers.

<u>Trade Teams</u> – OWC hosts over 10 teams annually providing information on SW supply and demand, crop quality and our marketing/ transportation system.

PNW Wheat Quality Council – Allows breeders to submit samples for review by the domestic milling industry.
