

June Status: Oregon Wheat

Beneficial rains in early June supported crop development throughout the state. Winter wheat headed out earlier than average, but cooler weather extended into mid-June. USDA projections in June placed expected Oregon winter wheat production at 50.1 million bushels, which would be up 23 percent from last year. Cooler weather extended into mid-June. Warming temperatures forecast through the end of the month will support crop progression.
