



We are thrilled to announce we have been given the “green light” by our local officials for our April 10-11 show! To meet social distancing recommendations, there will be some modifications. These changes may only be temporary, or they may become permanent depending on how the COVID landscape changes in the future. This is new territory for us and we are trying our best to make this show a success, but we need your help!

These modifications include:

- Every vendor will be **REQUIRED** to have hand sanitizer visible and available in their booth to shoppers at all times. You must have enough hand sanitizer to last the entire weekend.
- We encourage you to wear a mask while closely interacting with shoppers, volunteers, staff, and other vendors or while indoors.
- Our headquarters will have a strict one-out, one-in policy. **MASKS ARE REQUIRED TO ENTER HEADQUARTERS**. To help with wait times, all balances due will need to be paid by April 1st. You will receive a PayPal invoice from us in March that **MUST** be paid by the deadline.
- Buildings will have one-way entrances and exits to help with the flow of traffic. There will be signage and regular announcements made to help with this.
- We will need your help with clean-up efforts (masks that are thrown on ground, etc.) We anticipate that there will be lots of discarded masks- if we must hire extra workers to help with clean-up, this will only cause booth rent to increase for our vendors.
- Broadway Food Court **WILL** be spread out to help alleviate congestion. We are still hammering out details of spacing and electricity and are working hard to make it as fair and efficient as possible. We will be contacting food vendors individually to let you know how these changes affect you.

While we understand that there are varying opinions on both politics and the virus, we are focusing our energy on hosting a safe and successful show. Please remember that we are all working together for the same goal and ask that you treat everyone you encounter with respect.
