Summer Pineapple Cake

Ingredients:

- 1 8-oz crushed pineapple in unsweetened juice
- 1 package white cake mix
- 2 tbsp. water
- 1 egg white
- ¼ cup coconut (garnish)

Frosting

- ¼ cup butter
- 1 cup powdered sugar
- 2 tbsp. reserved pineapple juice

Directions:

1. Heat oven to 350 degrees. Spray 8-inch square pan with nonstick cooking spray. Remove 2 tbsp. pineapple liquid; set aside.
2. In medium bowl, combine cake mix, crushed pineapple with remaining liquid, water and egg white; beat at low speed until moistened. Beat 2 minutes at medium speed.
3. Pour into pan. Bake for 23 to 28 minutes or until toothpick comes out clean. Cool 30 minutes.
4. While cake is cooling, spread coconut evenly on ungreased cookie sheet. Bake at 350 for 4 to 7 minutes, or until golden brown, stirring once. Immediately remove from cookie sheet.
5. In a small bowl, beat butter until light. Add powdered sugar; beat well. Add reserved pineapple liquid; beat until smooth. Spread frosting over cooled cake. Sprinkle with toasted coconut.
