Mom's Carrot Cake

Ingredients:

- 2 cups sugar and flour
- 2 teaspoons baking soda and cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon Kosher salt
- 1 ¹/₂ cups vegetable oil
- 2 cups grated carrots
- 1 small can (8 oz) crushed pineapple w/juice
- 4 eggs
- ³/₄ cup chopped pecans (more if garnishing on the sides and top)

Frosting Ingredients:

- 2 sticks salted butter, softened
- 2 (8 oz) packages cream cheese, softened
- 1 tablespoon vanilla extract
- 1 (2 lb.) bag powdered sugar

Directions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
- 2. Combine dry ingredients, set aside.
- 3. Beat eggs with oil and sugar, beat to combine.
- 4. Add dry ingredients and stir until combined.
- 5. Stir in carrots, pineapple with juice and nuts; beat until just combined.
- 6. Pour into 3 greased 3 greased and floured 9-inch pans and bake at 350 for 25-30 minutes or until done when tested.
- 7. Let Cool Completely.
- 8. Combine frosting ingredients in a mixing bowl, then beat until smooth and fluffy, about 2 minutes.
- 9. Ice with cream cheese frosting.
