#### **Chicken Cordon Bleu Pasta**

### **Ingredients**

- 3 cups uncooked penne pasta
- 2 cups heavy whipping cream
- 1 (8 oz) package cream cheese, softened & cubed
- 1 ½ cups shredded Swiss Cheese, divided (1 cup and ½ cup)
- ½ teaspoon onion powder
- ½ teaspoon garlic salt
- ¼ teaspoon salt & pepper
- 3 cups sliced, cooked chicken breasts
- ¾ cups crumbled, cooked bacon
- ¾ cup cubed, fully cooked ham
- 3 tablespoons dry breadcrumbs

#### **Directions**

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Cook pasta according to package instructions.
- 2. Meanwhile, in a large saucepan, heat cream and cream cheese over medium heat until smooth, stirring occasionally. Stir in 1-cup of Swiss cheese, onion powder, garlic salt and pepper until blended.
- 3. Drain pasta. Stir in chicken, bacon and ham. Add sauce; toss to coat.
- 4. Transfer to a greased 9x13 baking dish. Sprinkle with remaining cheese and breadcrumbs.
- 5. Bake, uncovered, for 18-22 minutes or until heated through. Enjoy!
