Apple Pie Cake

#### Ingredients

#### • Topping

- o 1 cup Gold Medal<sup>TM</sup> all-purpose flour
- o 1/2 cup packed brown sugar
- o 1/4 teaspoon salt
- o 1/2 cup butter, cut into small pieces

#### o Apple Mixture

- o 6 apples, peeled, thinly sliced
- o 3 tablespoons packed brown sugar
- o 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- o 2 teaspoons lemon juice

#### o Cake

- o 1 box Betty Crocker<sup>™</sup> SuperMoist<sup>™</sup> yellow cake mix
- o 1 1/3 cups water
- o 1/3 cup oil
- o 3 eggs

#### Directions

• Heat oven to 350°F (325°F for dark or nonstick pan). Spray bottom and sides of 13x9-inch pan with baking spray with flour.

• In medium bowl, stir together flour, 1/2 cup brown sugar and the salt. With pastry blender or fork, cut in butter until mixture is crumbly. Set aside.

- In another medium bowl, gently stir together Apple Mixture ingredients; set aside.
- In large bowl, beat Cake ingredients with electric mixer on low speed 30 seconds, then on medium speed 2 minutes, scraping bowl occasionally. Pour into pan.
- Spread apple mixture evenly over cake batter. Sprinkle Topping evenly over top. 6 Bake 30 to 35 minutes or until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool completely, about 30 minutes.
