



Tex-Mex Chicken Salad

Ingredients:

- 1 ¼ lb. baked/grilled chicken (chopped)
- 1 small red pepper (chopped)
- 1 small red onion (chopped)
- 14 oz yellow corn (drained and rinsed)
- 1 can black beans (drained and rinsed)
- 1 bunch of cilantro (roughly chopped)
- ½ cup mayonnaise
- 1/4 cup sour cream
- ½ tsp ground cumin
- 1/4 tsp chili powder or Jerry

Directions:

Combine the mayonnaise, sour cream and chili powder and stir well. Pour over remaining ingredients and stir. Cover and refrigerate at least 2 hours. It's better to leave overnight.
