## **Impact Meeting**

Martin County had its very first Impact Meeting, January 10, 2017. Old Sorehead Trade Days sponsored the lunch. The idea for the meetings came from the Leadership Advisory Board, of Martin County AgriLife Extension. Representatives from local organizations gave reports. The food bank, reported new programs and serving about 150 families. Wes-Tex Telecom gave updates on fiber optics, Matthew Blocker reported on his application for petition. County Judge Bryan Cox updated the group on courthouse landscaping and new county jail progress. Sally Poteet gave an update with the Senior Citizens Center, which has a gym and is available to



anyone for \$25 a month and open Monday-Friday from 6:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Police Chief Schrover, informed of some additional services that local law enforcement provides, and requests if there is a problem to please contact the police department. The Chamber of Commerce announced Chamber Mixers which will begin and be available to members in March. Jennifer Weston of Permian Basin Regional Council on Alcohol and Drug Abuse informed of new programs launching at our Jr. High School and possible new ones to come. Amy Baugh gave an update for AgriLife Extension and new programs to be offered. Impact meetings will be held the second Tuesday of every month. The next meeting will be February 14, 2017 at the Senior Citizen Center, lunch is \$7 for under age 60 and \$3 donation for ages 60+. 



### Valentine's Day Muddy Buddies Recipe

### **Ingredients:**

- ½ bag pink Wilton Candy Malts
- 1/4 teaspoon shortening (like Crisco)
- 6 cups Chex Rice Cereal
- Gallon-sized Ziploc Bag
- 3 Cups confectioner sugar (more or less depending on your desired result)
- Various pink and red sprinkles

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Put Wilton Candy melts into microwave safe bowl.
- 2. Heat for 45 seconds, then stir. Heat an additional 30 seconds, then stir. If not completely melted, repeat in 20 second intervals until candy is completely melted.
- 3. Add ¼ teaspoon shortening and stir-this helps liquefy the candy melts and makes it easier to coat the rice cereal without getting too thick and lumpy.
- 4. In a gallon-sized Ziploc bag, pour Chex Rice Cereal and the melted candy melts.
- 5. Gently shake bag, rolling slowly to completely coat the rice cereal with the melted candy. Pour in the powdered sugar and shake until the cereal mixture is completely coated.
- 6. Pour into bowl and add sprinkles.
