

BBQ Chicken Nachos

Ingredients:

- 2 cups shredded chicken
- ¾ cup barbecue sauce
- 1 (18 oz) bag tortilla chips
- 3 cups shredded cheddar
- 1 cup crumbled Cotija
- 1 cup pickled jalapenos
- 1/2 small red onion (thinly sliced)
- 1 avocado (thinly sliced)
- Fresh chopped cilantro (for garnish)



Directions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 400 degrees and line a large baking sheet with foil. In a large bowl toss chicken with barbecue sauce.
- 2. Layer half the chips, cheddar, Cotija, chicken, pickled jalapenos, and onion. Repeat.
- 3. Bake until cheese is melted, and nachos are warmed through. About 15 minutes.
- 4. Top with avocado and cilantro before serving.
- 5. Enjoy!
