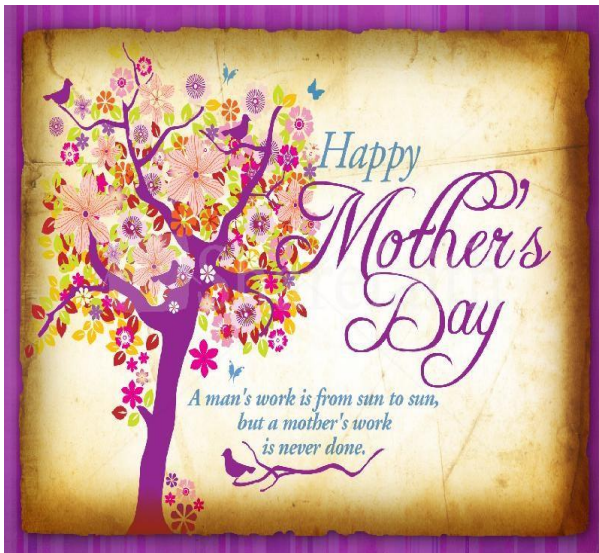

## Cilantro Chicken Salad

### Ingredients:

- **7 oz cooked chicken breasts (shredded or diced)**
- **2 tablespoons light mayonnaise**
- **1 scallion (small chopped)**
- **2 teaspoons lime juice**
- **2 tablespoons chopped cilantro**
- **Salt**
- **Pepper**
- **1 pinch each-garlic powder, cumin and chile powder**
- **Low sodium chicken broth**

### Directions:

**Combine chicken, mayonnaise, scallions, lime juice, and cilantro. Season to taste with salt, pepper, garlic powder, cumin, and chile powder. Add a little chicken broth if chicken seems too dry, 1 tbsp at a time.**
