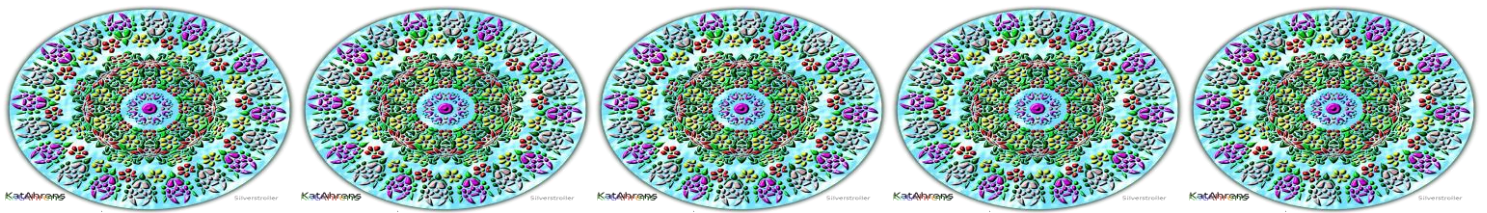

Miracle Mango Salsa Chicken

Ingredients:

- 6 boneless, skinless chicken thighs
- 1 cup long-grain white rice
- One 16-ounce jar mango salsa
- Salt
- Pepper
- Olive oil

Directions:

1. Preheat a large cast-iron skillet over medium heat.
2. Sprinkle the chicken thighs with salt and pepper on both sides. Add 2 tablespoons oil to the skillet and sear the chicken thighs until browned well, 2-3 minutes per side. Remove the chicken to a plate.
3. Add the rice, 1 ½ cups water and 1 cup of mango salsa. Stir and bring to a boil. Add the chicken back to the top of the rice, reduce to a simmer, cover and cook until the chicken and rice are cooked through, 17-20 minutes.
4. Serve up a pile of rice, topped with the chicken and garnished with additional mango salsa.
