## Sour Cream Chicken Enchiladas

### Ingredients

- 1 lb. chicken breast (diced)
- 1 medium onion (minced)
- 1 TBSP vegetable oil
- 8 flour tortillas (softened)
- 1 ½ cups grated Monterey Jack Cheese
- ¼ cup butter
- ¼ cup flour
- 1 can chicken broth
- 1 cup sour cream
- 1- 4 oz can chopped chilies

### Directions

1. In frying pan, cook onion and chicken together in oil over medium-high heat until chicken is just done.
2. Divide cooked chicken evenly between 8 tortillas, add 1 ½ TBSP of cheese to each.
3. Roll enchiladas and place seam-side down in 9x13 baking dish, sprayed lightly with cooking spray.
4. Melt butter in medium sauce pan, stir in flour to make a roux. Stir and cook until bubbly and gradually whisk in chicken broth. Bring to a boil, stirring frequently.
5. Remove from heat, stir in sour cream.
6. Pour sauce evenly over enchiladas.
7. Top with remaining cheese and bake at 400 degrees for 20 minutes.
