GOATS | REGULATIONS FOR ALL GOAT SHOWS:

1. Exhibitors entering open classes in this division must comply with Ozark Empire Fair General Rules and Regulations, Animal Health Requirements, Livestock Entry Rules and Show Ring Code of Ethics.
2. Exhibitors entering junior classes in this division must comply with Ozark Empire Fair Junior Show Rules and Regulations, General Rules, Livestock Entry Rules and Show Ring Code of Ethics.
3. **Entries close June 15**, and must be postmarked no later than midnight of this date. Late entries may be accepted through July 1. Entries post-marked after midnight June 15 and through midnight July 1 **MUST** be accompanied by the penalty fee, per head, as noted on the entry form in addition to regular stall and admission fees.
4. Entry forms are available on the website www.ozarkempirefair.com or at the Ozark Empire Fair Office. Entry forms may be photocopied. Entry may also be made online at www.ozarkempirefair.com.
5. **All classes entered must be shown on entry forms.**
6. Substitutions will be allowed within the division.
7. Registration and health papers must be in order as they will be checked against the information given on the entry form upon arrival on the Fairgrounds. All exhibitors must comply with animal health regulations as provided in the Exhibitors Handbook.
8. **No exhibitor shall occupy stalls without prior approval from superintendent. Exhibitor and animals may be removed from non-assigned stalls.**

Junior Breeding Show: 5 p.m., Sunday, August 1 | Open Show: 8 a.m., Monday, August 2

ARRIVAL: Must be in place by noon, Sunday, August 1. No arrival prior to 5 a.m., August 1.

RELEASE: 5 p.m., Monday, August 2.

The 2021 Ozark Empire Fair Boer Goat Show is sanctioned by the **American Boer Goat Association (ABGA)**.

1. Eligibility - Boer Goats must be registered in the name of the owner. All animals must have a legible tattoo or other means of permanent identification. If a microchip is the permanent identification, it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to provide a microchip reader for verification of animal identity. If permanent identification does not match the information presented on the registration certificate, the animal will be ineligible to compete. Permanent ID will be re-checked by the judge on the Grand and Reserve Grand Champions.
2. A registration certificate is required for all animals six months or older.
3. A stamped duplicate or faxed duplicate application showing the date received by registry office is required on all animals under six months of age.
4. The base date for computing ages shall be the date of judging. Dates shown are calculated with the Open Show date.
5. Complete reports of show results will be filed with the ABGA and points (and resultant titles) may be earned as may be set forth by the ABGA.
6. Animals with natural horns or disbudded or dehorned may be shown without discrimination.
7. An exhibitor shall not present an animal to be shown under a judge from whom it was purchased within 90 days of show.
8. Bucks must be controlled. No breeding is allowed on premises. Superintendent has discretion to order bucks restrained or removed.
9. Tack pens are not guaranteed or may be shared with other exhibitors.
10. Every Boer Goat must be properly fitted for show and equipped with a chain or collar.
11. Animals must be checked in by Noon, August 1. No substitutions after that time.
