RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Exhibitors entering this division should familiarize themselves with the **General Rules and Regulations and the Livestock Entry Rules** before submitting entries.
2. Entries can either be submitted through ShoWorks or by mail. The entry form is located at the end of this handbook. Early entries will close on June 15. Late entries will be available until July 1. All late entries must be added in the additional items section of ShoWorks or on the official entry form.
3. **See Livestock Entry Rules for health regulations. Please check with your veterinarian or Missouri Department of Agriculture regarding any changes in Equine Health Regulations that may have been updated.**
4. Age of horses, ponies, mules and foals will be figured from January 1. All foals will be considered as one year old on the first of January succeeding birth. Age of donkeys is actual birth date.
5. Minimum requirements for competition: (a.) No champions will be named unless there is competition. (b.) To remain listed in the Exhibitor Handbook, a minimum of 25 head must be shown in each section.
6. The management reserves the right to cancel any class in any section and to make substitution in case a class does not fill satisfactorily.
7. Show order may be changed at the discretion of the superintendent. Announcements regarding show schedule will supersede printed schedule.
8. When on exhibition, each animal must be under bridle or halter and in the charge of owner or an employee. All stallions two years and older must have a bit in mouth at all times.
9. Any animal that is not being controlled by driver or handler at any time, in or out of the show ring, may be confined to stall at discretion of fair staff.
10. Youth Classes: Driver must meet age requirements as specified and be accompanied by an adult. **PLEASE LIST DRIVER'S NAME ON ENTRY BLANK.**
11. No aged stallions may be used in the showmanship or decorating classes.
12. Appropriate dress must be worn while showing. Superintendent may institute a dress code and enforce it at his/her discretion.
13. **FEES:** \$25 per stall used (horse, tack, feed, etc.)
14. **STALLS:** Only 1 horse per stall (except for nursing foals). Stalls will be assigned by the division superintendent.
15. All draft horse breeds will show together (hitch & halter)
16. Four Horse Hitches placing out of the money will receive \$100 for showing.
17. Six Horse Hitches placing out of the money will receive \$200 for showing.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- Exhibitors entering this division should familiarize themselves with the **General Rules and Regulations and the Livestock Entry Rules** before completing entry form. Entry forms are available on the Ozark Empire Fair website www.ozarkempirefair.com or at the Ozark Empire Fair Office. Entry forms may be photocopied. Entry may also be made online at www.ozarkempirefair.com.
- Entries close **June 15** and those mailed must be postmarked no later than midnight of this date. Late entries may be accepted through July 1. Entries postmarked after midnight June 15 and through midnight July 1 must be accompanied by the penalty fee of \$22 per head in addition to regular stall and admission fees.
- Every entry must be made in the name of the bona fide owner.
- FEES:** Entry fee is \$23 per head plus the \$2 per head sanctioning fee. \$2 for each animal goes straight to the National Miniature Donkey Association. Tack/feed stalls (if available) are \$25. Each class is \$7 to enter.
- Stalls will be designated only by the division superintendent OR livestock office personnel.
- The management reserves the right to cancel any class in any section and to make substitution in case a class does not fill satisfactorily.
- Minimum requirements for competition:
 - No champions will be named unless there is competition.
 - To remain listed in the Exhibitor Handbook, a minimum of 25 head must be shown in each section.
- Age of horses, ponies, mules and foals will be figured from January 1. All foals will be considered as one year old on the first of January succeeding birth. Age of donkeys is actual birth date.
- When on exhibition, each animal must be under bridle or halter and in the charge of owner or an employee. All stallions two years and older must have a bit in mouth at all times.
- The show pattern will be outlined to exhibitors prior to the show by the superintendent.

ARRIVAL: Miniature Donkeys must be in place by 6 p.m. Sunday, August 2. No arrival prior to 2 p.m., Sunday, August 2

RELEASE: Miniature Donkeys will be released following conclusion of show on Tuesday, August 4, must be out of the barn by 6 a.m. on Wednesday, August 5, 2026.

The 2026 Ozark Empire Fair will host the National Show for the American Council of Spotted Asses.

This show has adopted the rules of National Miniature Donkey Association with the exception of the dress code rule. Due to the weather conditions, exhibitors will be allowed to wear equine dress appropriate for the weather conditions. Short sleeve shirts will be allowed. To download a copy of the National Miniature Donkey Association rule book visit www.nmdaasset.com.

- Donkeys must be at least 3 years old to participate in harness and jumping classes.
- Show officials reserve the right to cancel any class or division at its discretion, or to combine classes. Class show order will be determined once entries are received and processed. NATIONAL MINIATURE DONKEY ASSOCIATION SHOW RULES to govern Miniature Donkey classes according to current NMDA rulebook. All Miniature Donkeys must be registered prior to show. This show is approved by and will be run in accordance with the National Miniature Donkey Association, unless otherwise indicated. You are encouraged to view these rules available online: http://www.nmdaasset.com/downloads/NMDA_ShowRules.pdf. NMDA Fee: \$2.00 per Miniature Donkey will be assessed and due with entries. Not applicable to ACOSA classes.
- Animals entered in ACOSA designated classes MUST be registered with ACOSA and verification of that registration status submitted with their entries prior to the Fair. See www.spottedass.com for additional information.
- The NMDA classes are open to Miniature Donkeys registered with the Miniature Donkey Registry (MDR), the American Donkey Registry (ADR) or the Canadian Donkey & Mule Association (CDMA). Unregistered Miniature Donkeys will not be allowed to show. (Exception: ACOSA classes: see Rule 6 above.)
- Maximum height for animals entered in the NMDA Miniature Donkey classes is 36" with the exception of animals entered in the TEAM classes, which can be up to 38". Donkeys will be measured Sunday evening starting at 5 p.m. in the equine barn.
- The age of a Miniature Donkey, for the purpose of entering this competition, will be determined by its actual birth date. Foals must be a minimum of six (6) months of age and all donkeys in jumping and/or driving classes must be three (3) years or older.
- Youth exhibitors: Competitors 17 years of age and under may not show a jack two years or older in any NMDA class. The age of an individual on January 1st will be maintained throughout entire year.
- OZARK EMPIRE FAIR HIGH POINT AWARDS: Pursuant to NMDA rules, it IS necessary that jacks/jennets be entered, shown and judged in at least one halter (conformation) class to be eligible for Performance High Point award consideration. It is NOT necessary for GELDINGS to enter or show in a conformation halter class to be eligible for any of the Performance High Point awards. 2026 Ozark Empire Fair Miniature Donkey Show Competition Guide **HIGH POINT CALCULATION:** For classes of five or more animals, first place will receive 5 points, with the remaining places receiving one less point in descending order. For classes of less than five animals, first place will receive points equal to the number in the class, with the remaining places receiving one less point in descending order.
- TIES:** High point ties will be broken by the number of first places, then by number of classes placed in, then by the highest placing in Pleasure Driving (or in hand and trail for Non-Driving Divisions.) b. To be eligible for any of the High Point awards, the Miniature Donkey (or Team) must be duly entered, shown and judged in classes to be considered for any high point award. Placings in Championship Halter classes and all ACOSA designated classes will NOT count toward any High Point award.

- Classes are open to grade animals unless designated as Registered.
- Birthdate, animal name and registration number (if registered animal) must be submitted on the entry form for all entries or entry will not be accepted.** Only those animals with proper registration will be allowed in registered classes. Registration number will not be required for current year registered foals, however, birthdate and name must be submitted on entry form and animal should be designated as "registered".
- Any animal that is not being controlled by driver or handler at any time, in or out of the show ring, may be confined to stall at discretion of fair staff.
- Farm Hitch Class: No Driver or team may be in any other two-pony hitch. Ponies may be hitched to any farm implement or wagon except mowing machines or sulky rakes. Obstacle class will not be considered to be two-pony hitch. Harness, shoes, manes and tails will not be a factor in judging of farm hitch class.
- Ride-A-Pony will be conducted as follows: drive in a single pony in two-wheel cart. Line-up, dismount, un-hitch and un-harness. Ride pony bareback to the designated spot. This is a timed and judged event. Detailed information will be provided by superintendent prior to show.
- Youth Cart Class is open to youth under 16 years of age as of January 1, 2026. Youth driver must have adult co-driver riding with them.
- Those who participate in the women's cart class or youth cart class are not eligible to compete in the open cart class.

2. Entries close **June 15** and those mailed must be postmarked no later than midnight of this date. Late entries may be accepted through July 1. Entries postmarked after midnight June 15 and through midnight July 1 must be accompanied by the penalty fee of \$25 per head in addition to regular stall and admission fees.
3. Every entry must be made in the name of the bona fide owner.
4. **FEES:** Entry fee is \$25 per head. Mare and foal count as two animals. No more than two animals per stall. Tack/feed stalls (if available) are \$25.
5. Stalls will be designated only by the division superintendent.
6. The management reserves the right to cancel any class in any section and to make substitution in case a class does not fill satisfactorily.
7. **See Livestock Entry Rules for health regulations. Please check with your veterinarian or Missouri Department of Agriculture regarding any changes in Equine Health Regulations that may have been updated.**
8. Minimum requirements for competition:
 - a. No champions will be named unless there is competition.
 - b. To remain listed in the Exhibitor Handbook, a minimum of 25 head must be shown in each section.
9. Age of horses, ponies, mules and foals will be figured from January 1. All foals will be considered as one year old on the first of January succeeding birth. Age of donkeys is actual birth date.
10. When on exhibition, each animal must be under bridle or halter and in the charge of owner or an employee. All stallions two years and older must have a bit in mouth at all times.
11. The show pattern will be outlined to exhibitors prior to the show by the superintendent.
12. Youth Cart Classes: Driver must meet age requirements as specified and be accompanied by an adult. **PLEASE LIST DRIVER'S NAME ON ENTRY BLANK.**
13. Feed boxes must be provided by the exhibitor.
14. Appropriate dress must be worn while showing. Superintendent may institute a dress code and enforce it at his/her discretion.
15. Show order may be changed at the discretion of the superintendent. Announcements regarding show schedule will supersede printed schedule.
