- 1. Exhibitors entering <u>open classes</u> in this division must comply with Ozark Empire Fair General Rules and Regulations, Animal Health Requirements, Livestock Entry Rules and Show Ring Code of Ethics.
- 2. Exhibitors entering <u>junior classes</u> in this division must comply with Ozark Empire Fair Junior Show Rules and Regulations, General Rules, Livestock Entry Rules and Show Ring Code of Ethics.
- 3. All entries are to be submitted through our online entry portal, ShoWorks. Link can be found at www.ozarkempirefair.com.
- 4. Entries must be turned in by June 15th to avoid late entry fees. Entries with late entry fees will be accepted by July 1st.
- 5. Substitutions will be allowed within the division.
- 7. Registration and health papers must be in order as they will be checked against the information given on the entry form upon arrival on the Fairgrounds. All exhibitors must comply with animal health regulations as provided in the Exhibitors Handbook.
- 8. All Champions are mandated to taking a picture with the official fair photographer at the back drop.
- 9. No exhibitor shall occupy stalls without prior approval from superintendent. Exhibitor and animals may be removed from non-assigned stalls.

JUNIOR BOER GOAT SHOWMANSHIP:

Three Classes will be offered based on age of youth as of January 1, 2024. Day of entries are accepted. Classes; **Junior** (Ages 8-11); **Intermediate** (Ages 12-15); **Senior** (Ages 16-21) Sign up for showmanship will happen among arrival.

YOUTH DAIRY GOAT SHOWMANSHIP:

Three Classes will be offered based on age of youth as of January 1, 2024. Day of Entries are accepted. Classes; **Junior** (Ages 8-11); **Intermediate** (Ages 12-15); **Senior** (Ages 16-21) Sign up for showmanship will happen among arrival.

BOER GOATS | Division 10

Junior Breeding Show: 8 a.m., Friday, August 2 | Diamond Open Show: 4 p.m., Friday, August 2 | Emerald Open Show: 8 a.m., Saturday, August 3 ARRIVAL: Must be in place by noon on Thursday, August 1. No arrival prior to 6 a.m., August 1. RELEASE: 7 p.m., Saturday, August 3. The 2024 Ozark Empire Fair Boer Goat Shows are sanctioned by the American Boer Goat Association (ABGA).

- 1. Eligibility Boer Goats must be registered in the name of the owner. All animals must have a legible tattoo or other means of permanent identification. If a microchip is the permanent identification, it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to provide a microchip reader for verification of animal identity. If permanent identification does not match the information presented on the registration certificate, the animal will be ineligible to compete. Permanent ID will be re-checked by the judge on the Grand and Reserve Grand Champions.
- 2. A registration certificate is required for all animals six months or older.
- 3. The base date for computing ages shall be the date of judging. Dates shown are calculated with the Open Show date.
- 4. Complete reports of show results will be filed with the ABGA and points (and resultant titles) may be earned as may be set forth by the ABGA.
- 5. Animals with natural horns or disbudded or dehorned may be shown without discrimination.
- 6. An exhibitor shall not present an animal to be shown under a judge from whom it was purchased within 90 days of show.
- 7. Bucks must be controlled. No breeding is allowed on premises. Superintendent has discretion to order bucks restrained or removed.
- 8. Every Boer Goat must be properly fitted for show and equipped with a chain or collar.
- 9. There will be an entry fee for BOTH open shows. If you want to show in both, enter into both and pay each entry fee.
- 10. Junior exhibitors must enter into at least ONE open show in order to be eligible for the junior show.

- 1. All animals must be registered with a recognized organization. Proof of ownership registration certificate and tattoo requirements will be needed. All goats shown must exhibit well-healed tattoos and must be correctly tattooed.
- 2. All animals 6 months of age or older must show registry certificate. A stamped or fax duplicate application showing date received by registry office is required on all animals under 6 months of age. Animals must be owned by exhibitor. Exhibitor is the name which appears on registry certificate.
- 3. All goats shown must be owned by the exhibitor or must show transfer of ownership to exhibitor by July 1, 2024.
- 4. Every goat must be properly fitted for show and provided with a collar. All exhibitors must be neatly and properly dressed (preferably in white) while in show ring.

YOUTH

OPEN

- No milkout will be required. However, over-extended udders will be discriminated against.
- Animals to be shown in group classes must be entered and shown in individual classes.
- 7. No dairy goat bucks allowed on the Fairgrounds.
- 8. Tack pens are not guaranteed or may be shared with other exhibitors.
- 9. Youth Show will begin at 2 p.m. with showmanship classes first.
- 10. All group classes are \$5 to enter. No ringside entries will be accepted upon arrival of the fairgrounds.

Mini Dairy Goat show will be sanctioned by Mini Dairy Goat Association, if minimum number of animals are entered.

MDGA and Ozark Empire Fair rules shall govern the show. www.miniaturedairygoats.net

- 1. To fulfill the sanction requirement for an MDGA show, a minimum of eight animals, from at least two exhibitors, must participate.
- 2. Base date for computing age is July 30.
- 3. In order for animals to be accepted for participation in an MDGA show, the owner must present either an official registration certificate or a registrarissued confirmation email with a registration number assigned to each animal being considered for registration from a recognized miniature dairy goat association. All goats shown must exhibit well-healed tattoos and must be correctly tattooed.
- 4. All goats shown must be owned by the exhibitor or must show transfer of ownership to exhibitor by July 1, 2024.
- 5. Every goat must be properly fitted for show and provided with a collar. All exhibitors must be neatly and properly dressed (preferably in white) while in show ring.
- 6. No milkout will be required. However, over-extended udders will be discriminated against.
- 7. Animals to be shown in group classes must be entered and shown in individual classes.
- 8. No dairy goat bucks allowed on the Fairgrounds.
- 9. Tack pens are not guaranteed and/or may be shared with other exhibitors.
