RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Hay or haylage must be harvested in the State of Missouri in 2021.
- Entries may be either dry hay or haylage in either small bales or large packages.
- Exhibitors are limited to two entries per class. No more than one entry per field, per cutting, may be made.
- Sampling of the hay will be done by the University of Missouri regional faculty or a designated person, such as FFA advisors.
- Entries will be tested for moisture, crude protein, acid detergent fiber, neutral detergent fiber. Calculations will be made for energy values Relative Forage Quality (RFQ).
- An entry will consist of core samples from ten bales.
- The entries will be tested at Custom Laboratory, Monett, MO
- Entry fee will be \$23 per sample. Make checks payable to: Ozark Empire Fair. Send samples to Custom Lab, Monett.
- Send the entry form and check to Lawrence County Extension Center, P.O. Box 388, Mt. Vernon, MO 65712.
- Placings in each class are based entirely on the RFQ values. There is no subjective evaluation of the hay or haylage.
- Entry deadline is July 19, 2021.
- Ribbons and prize money will be mailed to the exhibitor after August 31, 2021.
- An educational display of hay quality will be set up in the hay show area.
