

W.D. PIPKIN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION NOTES AND RULES - 2023

ELIGIBILITY

1. An applicant must be a graduating high school senior at least 17 years old as of July 31, 2023, and shall not be more than 21 years old as of July 15, 2023.
2. An applicant must have exhibited **breeding** beef cattle at the Ozark Empire Fair held in 2021 and 2022.
3. An applicant must intend to major in an agriculture-related field at a two- or four-year college, university or trade school.
4. An applicant may receive this award one time only.

USE OF FUNDS AWARDED

1. The winner of this scholarship may use the funds toward the following purposes associated with the pursuit of a post-secondary education:
 - (A) Tuition
 - (B) Textbooks
 - (C) Lab or other course fees required.
2. The funds will be distributed to the post-secondary institution upon proof of enrollment (copy of next semester's schedule) to the Ozark Empire Fair Foundation. The check will be issued to the student's college account.

APPLICATION DEADLINE AND OTHER INFORMATION

1. The completed application must be **delivered or mailed** (no faxed copies permitted) to the Ozark Empire Fair office no later than 4:00 p.m., July 1, 2023. If using mail or other delivery service, applicant must send forms in sufficient time so **delivery** can be made by the noted time.
2. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
3. Do not use more space than is allotted for answers. Do not attach other information.
