RABBITS

Junior Show: 9 a.m., Saturday, July 27 | Open Show: Following Junior Show, Saturday, July 27 ARRIVAL: Must be in place by 10 a.m., Friday, July 26. Earliest Arrival: 8 a.m. July 26. RELEASE: 6:30 p.m., Sunday, July 28.

- Fees: \$3 for single rabbits, \$2 for fur class, \$2 for meat pen. Rabbits entered in fur classes also must be entered in regular classes. Fur classes are defined as normal white and normal colored. Meat pens are defined as three rabbits, same breed, same variety, each under five pounds, up to 10 weeks old and as near matched as possible. No rabbits may be taken from the rabbit barn until release time on Sunday. Rabbits not entered in the show are not allowed in the barn.
- Each exhibitor will be sent admission credentials for bringing and picking up entries. Please use Gate 10. An official release slip must accompany entries leaving the grounds. Anyone leaving before release time will forfeit all prize money won and the right to further participation. Additional admission tickets may be purchased on your entry form.
- Eligibility: Each rabbit must be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor and permanently earmarked in the left ear with a legible tattoo, with ear mark entered on entry blank. ENTRY CLOSING DATE IS JULY 1.
- NO late entries accepted. Please complete all information as requested on entry blank.
- Use code supplied on entry blank for age and sex. 5.
- The show is limited to 300 rabbits.
- **Substitutions:** Substitutions are allowed only within the same class, breed and sex. 7.
- Management: The management reserves the right to refuse any entry that is not deemed in the best interest of the show. 8.
- An experienced superintendent will be in charge of this division, and all animals will be cooped and watered free. EXHIBITORS MUST FEED THEIR OWN RABBITS AND PROVIDE THEIR OWN FEED PRODUCT. The Ozark Empire Fair will not be responsible for loss or accident; however, every precaution will be taken to eliminate any danger of mistakes in the show room and return of stock.
- 10. This is an official ARBA sanctioned show and will be governed by the latest revised rules of said association, and filing of entry indicates acceptance of same. SANCTIONS GUARANTEED.
- 11. The Ozark Empire Fair guarantees payment of all specials in this division. These specials are open to anyone, unless otherwise specified. There must be five or more rabbits in each breed to qualify for specials (unless otherwise specified).

YOUTH ARBA SHOW: Youth may NOT enter their rabbit in both open and youth classes. Youth may make entries in both open and youth classes with different animals. Youth exhibitors may enter sanctioned youth shows between the ages of five (5) and eighteen (18) years. Youth exhibitors are not required to carry their own animals to the table. All youth exhibitors must use their own individual name, but may add a rabbitry name when entering youth shows. Entries will not be accepted in family or rabbitry names. If owned in conjunction with another youth, the names of all owners must be listed.
