

- Every participating fair must submit the Contest Summary Report **by November 15** either through the Google Form <https://forms.gle/hVZAxuVU41wiQRjYA> or by paper form.
- Fairs **no** longer fill out any Farm Show Certification Entry forms. Those Certification Forms will be sent by the PA Special Baking Contest Committee directly to the winners as designated in the fairs' Contest Summary Forms.
- If a first-place winner is unable to attend the state finals, the PA Fairs Special Baking committee will certify the next available winner listed on the fair's Contest Summary.
- Local winners should **NOT** register directly with the PA Farm Show to compete in the Farm Show special baking finals. The Certification Entry Form signed by the PA Fairs Special Baking committee is their "ticket" to enter. Instructions are listed on the Certification Entry Form.
