General Rules and Regulations

Hogs shall weigh 200 lbs. or more to be entered in the Swine Fitting and Showing at Palouse Empire Fair.

To enter Market classes, weight shall be 240-300 lbs.

Division A = FFA Fitting and Showing

Division B = 4-H Fitting and Showing

Points Awarded: Blue 80, Red 50, White 20

Class:

1. 4-H Junior 8-10 years 4-H
2. 4-H Intermediate 11 – 13 years 4-H
3. 4-H Senior 14 - < 19 years 4-H
4. FFA Beginner: No previous hogs experience FFA
5. FFA Novice: Freshman & Sophomore FFA
6. FFA Advanced: Junior & Senior FFA

Division C = FFA Market Hogs

Division D = 4-H Market Hogs

Points Awarded: Blue 80, Red 50, White 20

Class:

1. Market hogs will be entered in Sub-Class 1 and they will be divided into classes according to weight.

Division E = FFA Educational Displays

Division F = 4-H Educational Displays

Class:

1. Poster or Display (Individual)  
Points Awarded: Blue 25, Red 20, White 15
2. Barn Display (Group)  
Points Awarded: Blue 35, Red 25, White 15

## Lil Squealers Showmanship

Department 103 Open

Division A =Open Youth

Points Awarded: Blue 75, Red 55, White 35

Rules:

- Due to lack of space, all "Lil Squealers" must show a hog that is currently entered as a 4-H/FFA project.
- Only forty entries will be taken.
- This is an open class youth program for ages 5 through 8 years of age who are not eligible for 4-H market at time of Fair.
- Hogs must weigh between 200 and 300 lbs. at check in time on Wednesday prior to fair.
- Hogs must stay at Fair from Wednesday through Sunday at close of Fair.
- Hogs must have health papers at check in on Wednesday.
- Showmen must follow barn rules for taking care of their animal.
- Classes will be judged following fitting and showing requirements.
- Hog will not be sold at the Junior Market stock sale, showman will be responsible for the hogs' removal from the fairgrounds at close of Fair.
- If hog is property of a sibling that is shown in 4-H or FFA market divisions and is otherwise eligible to be sold, the older sibling shall be allowed to sell pig as their one market animal.
- Because of the age and need for exhibitor's safety, special arrangements will be made for show ring appearances under the guidance of the barn superintendent.
