Palouse Empire Fair Camping Rules

- If you choose not to read the following you are still held liable and responsible for following the rules.
- All camping is reserved through the Palouse Empire Fair Office – No subletting of spaces.
- Large animal exhibitors and barn superintendents receive priority in camping reservations.
- Camping Rates: \$65 Power & Water Hookups, \$50 Power Hookup only, \$35 Dry – No Hookups.
- Your space will be confirmed once payment has been received with a confirmation email.
- Upon arrival at the Fairgrounds, please check in at the Fair Office to pick up camping packet.
- No vehicle movement in any of the campground areas during Fair hours of operation Thursday, Friday, Saturday 8:00 a.m. – 9:00p.m. Sunday 8:00a.m. – 4:00p.m.
- Gates for vehicles to access campground open at 9:00 p.m. and close at 8:00 a.m. on Thursday, Friday and Saturday, and open 4:00p.m. and close at 8:00a.m. on Sunday
- Camping Permit must be displayed and visible to Campground Superintendent on your camping vehicle.
- Placement of vehicle over 40' and wider than 13' are up to the discretion of the Fair Office.
- Tipouts must fit in within assigned space. Please be accurate with R.V. dimensions on page one.
- Air Conditioners are not allowed unless powered by a gas generator.
- Quiet time is 10:00p.m. - 7:00a.m. You may not run generators during these hours.
- Campers must respect the rights of neighboring campers while staying on the Fairgrounds. Campers found to be disruptive will be asked to leave, forfeit the camping fee, and forfeit camping the following year.
- One small tent maybe set up in conjunction with a reserved camper/RV/trailer space.
- Cancellation Policy – Cancellations must be made by July 1st for a full refund of the camping fee.
- Under age youths may not be left unsupervised in any camper/RV/trailer or any campsite. There must be at least one adult staying with youth(s) in your camper/RV/trailer or at your campsite during evening hours and overnight.
- Owners of campers/RVs/trailers/tents visiting the Whitman County / Palouse Empire Fair campsites will hold Whitman County harmless for any damages sustained while camping. Whitman County is not responsible for any stolen items from the campsite.
- Exhibitors are asked to leave their pets at home. Dogs, other than a Service Animal or show animal, are not allowed. Pets must be kept on a leash. Pets may not be left tied outside in your campsite unsupervised. Pet waste must be immediately picked up and disposed of in the proper trash receptacles. Barking, aggressive behavior, or failure to follow rules are grounds for immediately revoking your use of campgrounds.
