How to Enter:

1. Livestock Judging Contest is open to all FFA Chapters and 4-H members.
2. Each contestant will place in six classes of livestock (sheep, swine, beef, and goats).
3. Each contestant will yield grade at least 5 market steers, 4-H being the exception.
4. Suitable banners will be awarded to the three top placing FFA teams and prizes to the three top 4-H individuals (in each age group.)
5. Registration for 4-H youth will be at 8:00 a.m. sharp in the YAP barn for the livestock judging contest on Saturday.

How to Enter:

- Open to all 4-H and FFA members selling an animal in this year's Junior Market Stock Sale.
- Contestants will be Fitting and Showing Champions who won while showing their market animal selling in the Junior Market Stock Sale.
- If the Fitting and Showing Champion does not meet the qualifications, the Reserve Champion will take their place in the contest as long as they meet contest qualifications.
- Contestants shall compete on all four market animals to be judged Round Robin Champion.
- The Round Robin contest will be on Saturday, starting in the Swine barn, check with your Barn Superintendent for more details.
- Only 2 prizes are awarded overall, unless there is a tie.
- If there is a tie, each winner will receive the designated prize money.
