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## Cook's Choice Rules and Regulations

1. Participants must be on a cook team entered into the PLS&R cookoff
2. This is an open category and any food item(s) is permitted
3. Teams may enter a single item or a meal
4. Teams may set up or decorate the judging area in their cook team as they wish
5. Teams are allowed to perform a skit, but it is not required
6. Teams will prepare for four (4) judges
7. Teams will provide the plates/bowls and silverware needed by the judges

Entries will be judged on the following criteria:

**Overall presentation of the entry** – Did the team welcome you in? Was there an explanation of the entry to the judges? Did the judging area impress you?

**Taste** – Is it pleasing to the taste buds? Does it make you want to eat more? Is there an appropriate balance of flavor?

**Appearance** – Is it pleasing to the eye? Does it look appetizing? Did it make you want to eat it?

**Execution** – Did the dish come together? Did the cook successfully accomplish what they described? Was there any originality of the dish?

The judges will give a score out of ten for each criterion, 1 being inedible, 10 being excellent.

Judges will score independently, impartially, with integrity, competence and diligence.
