REPORT BY SMG TO COMMITTEE

Lexus Room – The project is moving forward, it will be broken down in two phases. Some of the labor will be completed in-house and what can not be completed will be contracted out. Changes that will be made are the door entrance, flooring, paint, adding a buffet area, and riser floors with booths. A proposal may be presented in the next Capital Committee meeting.

Section 4 Suite Box – New counter tops have been installed, and flooring will be completed today.

The Capital budget is \$600,000 and out of that \$148,000 has been spent.

OLD BUSINESS

Arena LED Project – Currently working with Ameren on the incentive. Musco and Ephesus are two arena lighting companies. Ephesus lighting offers color tuning, it is adjustable from a cooler to warmer light. Mosco lighting does not offer color tuning lighting. Ameren incentive is also bigger with Mosco lighting compared to Ephesus. Will is looking into why the incentive is different, after that it will go to the committee for approval in May. The goal is to have the lighting installed before September.

Das System – Met with Heart – Looking to get an RFP to go out to interested companies to send in their proposals.
