The YTD budget is \$600,000 and out of that we have spent \$228,000, out of which \$150,000 went to the LED Lighting Project. Many of last month's purchases were related to the Lexus Club remodel, this project is going well as a new paint scheme has just been completed. On July 12th, work will be complete on this remodel. Mr. Sutherland is working on a plan for the opening as well. We are also working with catering to enhance the food service offered, such as packages for Riverman games.

Square Card Readers were purchased for Novelties and have sped up sales, allowing us to increase revenue as well as improve selling accuracy and accountability for individual sellers.

Catering/Concession Point of Sale equipment has been upgraded as well in order to keep equipment current and running properly.

There are also a few mechanical projects that we are currently working on.
