RULES

- 1. Each exhibitor may enter <u>only one animal</u> in the ribbon auction. Those animals eligible include market or breeding animals, of any animal housed on the grounds for the duration of the fair, with the exception of the Adopt a Pigs & Bacon Buddies. Adopt a Pigs & Bacon Buddies are not eligible for the Ribbon Auction. See the sale order above for all eligible species. No late sign-ups will be accepted.
- 2. Bid increments will be determined by the auctioneers as the sale progresses. The winning bid will represent the amount the buyer will pay the Fair Board, who in turn will pay the exhibitor. All winning bid checks should be made payable to **Plymouth County Fair Board** the day of the auction. Ribbon Auction checks made out after the auction should also be made payable to the Plymouth County Fair Board and either turned in, or mailed to, the Plymouth County Fair Board, c/o Plymouth County Extension Office, 251 12th St. SE, Le Mars, IA 51031.
- 3. Exhibitors retain ownership of all animals brought through the Ribbon Auction.
 - *** Each Exhibitor gets **one** opportunity to go thru the Ribbon Auction. For example, if an exhibitor shows poultry, sheep <u>and</u> swine, he/she chooses one of those animals to take thru the ring.
