CREATIVE HOBBIES GENERAL RULES

**** Suggestion to participants: You may write a note to the judges with details about your project that you feel the judges should know.**

1. The Creative Hobbies & Art Show is open to Plymouth County residents only.
2. All entries must be the work of the exhibitor and must be original.
3. Items previously entered cannot be re-entered.
4. Anyone who teaches or sells their hobby or art items for profit must enter under the professional class for that division.
5. Entries must be brought in between 6:00pm-8:00 pm Tuesday, July 23, 2024, and 7:00am-10:00 am Wednesday, July 24, 2024. LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR CHAMPION RIBBON.
6. No one allowed in building during judging. Judging will begin at 9:00 a.m. Wednesday. The Open Class Building WILL NOT BE OPEN for public viewing on Wednesday, July 24th until judging and set-up is complete. This is the only day it does not open at 10 a.m.
7. Each person is limited to four entries per division. Divisions are the letters.
8. Entries will be released between 7:00pm-8:00 pm on Sunday, July 28th only. NO Monday release time. Exhibitors must pick up entries and premiums at this time. If you are unable to pick up your entries, make arrangements for someone else to pick it up for you. Items picked up by someone other than the entrant may be required to sign a release form. Any items left over will be taken to the Fair Board Office until noon on Monday, July 29. Items not picked up between Sunday 7:00pm -8:00pm will forfeit their premium.
9. Premiums will be awarded in each division as follows: Grand Champion - Purple \$5.00; Reserve Champion - Lavender \$3.00; Blue \$2.00; Red \$1.50; White \$1.00. Special Judge's Choice Awards will also be presented. Judges Choice Awards given by Craft Den, \$10 gift certificate; Div. F thru Q –

\$20.00 Cash - by Budget Automotive. New Last Year is a Best of Show Award. 1 for quilts and 1 for the rest of the open class entries. Also new are honorable mention ribbons. Best of Show and honorary mention are honorary ribbons, no premiums are given.

10. Judges have the right to limit the number of grand and reserve champion ribbons based on number of entries. Example: Some classes may have two reserve and no grand champion ribbons awarded.
11. The Plymouth County Fair Board and the Creative Hobbies & Art Show Superintendents are not responsible for damage or loss of exhibits but will use care to ensure their safety.
12. The professional class will be judged separately. A Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion will be awarded based on number of entries.
13. Anyone found entering under another's name or isn't a Plymouth County resident will forfeit their ribbon and the entry will be removed.
14. Copyright entries are prohibited. They cannot be judged or displayed. Example: You can draw a picture of a robot but if you write "transformer" on the drawing, this is a copyright infringement. Also, sports teams logos are copyrighted. Anything with a © on it cannot be reproduced.
15. Scrapbooking Division is for one page and must contain at least one picture.
16. If you are a Grand Champion Ribbon winner, pictures will be taken at 1:00 p.m. on Saturday July 29th, in the Open Class Building.

ART SHOW GENERAL RULES

**** Suggestion to participants: You may write a note to the judges with details about your project that you feel the judges should know.**

1. Open to Plymouth County Residents Only.
 2. Artwork must be original, not copyrighted and not previously submitted. No coloring book pages, they can be entered in the Creative Hobbies Section.
 3. No copies of entries can be submitted elsewhere at the fair.
 4. Art entries will be classified as:
 - Division A:** Two-dimensional art including oil, acrylic, watercolor, tempera, charcoal, pastel, pencil, pen and ink, collage of media, graphic art or other media **see hanging requirements**
 - Division B:** Three-dimensional art including sculpture, hand carved or turned wood, hand built. ceramics, pottery or other media. Exhibits may include a stand or pedestal.
 5. All exhibitors will be limited to 4 entries per division.
 6. Hanging requirements:
 - a. 2D Art may or may not be matted. No tape will be allowed to construct a hanger – we suggest rubber cement.
 - b. If no hanger is supplied – we will use black clips to hang – which may leave an indent in your mat or artwork.
 - c. Framed art and stretched canvas **MUST BE** equipped with a wire hanger and metal screws secured into the frame. Glass in the frame is allowed but has a risk of being broken. We take all precautions, but accidents do happen. We are not responsible for accidental breakage.
 7. Classes in each Division will be as follows:
 - Class 0 : Preschool - 4 years
 - Class 1 : 5 - 6 years
 - Class 2 : 7 - 8 years
 - Class 3 : 9 - 11 years
 - Class 4 : 12 - 14 years
 - Class 5: 15-18 years
 - Class 6: 19 years and up
 - Class 7: Professional
- Ages reflect age at fair time, not when artwork was created. A professional is defined as any artist who invests time in his/her art – Teaching, selling, taking commissions, or exhibiting for the purpose of selling.
8. . Entries must be brought in between 6:00pm-8:00 pm Tuesday, July 23, 2024, and 7:00am-10:00 am Wednesday, July 24, 2024, for registration.

9. The Superintendent has the right to refuse to display any artwork that is not acceptable in a family setting.
10. Judging will take place after 9 am on Wednesday and the exhibit building will not be open again until the last piece of art has been judged and hung. Any piece that comes apart due to the use of tape or insufficient mounting / hanging equipment before the end of the show will be disqualified and any ribbons or premiums awarded will be forfeited.
11. Premiums will be awarded as follows:
 - 1st place – Blue - \$2.00
 - 2nd place - Red - \$1.50
 - 3rd place – White - \$1.00
 - Best of Show is an Honorary Position
12. Grand and Reserve Champion ribbons will be awarded in each class IF THERE IS MERIT, discretion is up to the judge.
 - Best of Show will be awarded to one piece of art from the entire show and will be decided on by all judges.
13. Entries will be released between 7:00pm-8:00 pm on Sunday, July 28th only. NO Monday release time. Exhibitors must pick up entries and premiums at this time. If you are unable to pick up your entries, make arrangements for someone else to pick it up for you. Items picked up by someone other than the entrant may be required to sign a release form. Any items left over will be taken to the Fair Board Office until noon on Monday, July 29th. Items not picked up between 7:00pm -8:00pm Sunday will forfeit their premium.
