# **2024 OPEN CLASS PHOTOGRAPHY**

**Please read carefully, as rules and classes have been changed.**

### **GENERAL RULES**

1. The Open Class Photography Show is open to residents of Plymouth County.
2. All Photography entries will be classified as:  
**Division P (Photography):** Includes monochrome (black and white/sepia) or color photos. Photos must be 8 X 10, printed on photo paper and matted only! **No canvas printed photos allowed.**
3. All exhibitors will be limited to **3 entries total**.
4. **Matting Requirements**
  - a. All photography must be matted. **No exposed rubber cement allowed. No frames allowed. (Photos will be displayed using Velcro dots)**
  - b. Matting only includes precut mats, backing paper or board, no hanger required. Suggested places to purchase mats: The Craft Den, Hobby Lobby, Michael's Walmart, Amazon, etc.
5. Classes are as follows:
  - Class Pre: under 5 years
  - Class 1: 5 – 6 years
  - Class 2: 7 – 8 years
  - Class 3: 9 – 11 years
  - Class 4: 12 – 14 years
  - Class 5: 15 – 18 years
  - Class 6: 19 - 54 years
  - Class 7: Professional
  - Class SR: 55 years and up
  - Class SN: Adults with Disabilities
  - Class F: Feature Class – 2024 Featured Subject: Barns (see below)**

**\*Ages reflect age at fair time, not age when art work was created.**

**\*A professional is defined as any artist who invests time in his/her art– teaching, selling, taking commissions, or exhibiting for the purpose of selling.**

**Class F: Feature Class – 2024 – Barns:**

**NEW** for 2024, we will begin a rotating subject feature class. 2024's feature subject is Barns. Photos entered into this class need to feature a barn as the subject. Examples include, but are not limited to, landscapes featuring barns, livestock or animals around barns, inside of barns and more. This class will be judged based on all other photo critiques and the showcase of a barn.

6. All photos will be judged on, but not limited to, the following criteria: Focus, Exposure, Lighting, Depth of Field, Composition, Rule of Thirds, Cropping, and Matting.
7. Entries may be brought into the Open Class Building between 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, July 23<sup>rd</sup>, and between 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, July 24<sup>th</sup> for registration.
8. Any questions can be directed to the superintendents prior to fair week via call or text.
9. The Superintendents have the right to refuse to display any entries.
10. Judging will take place on Wednesday, and the exhibit will not be open again until the last piece has been judged and hung.
11. Premiums will be awarded as follows:
  - Grand Champion – Purple, \$5.00;
  - Reserve Champion – Lavender, \$3.00;
  - 1st – Blue, \$2.00;
  - 2nd - Red, \$1.50;
  - 3rd – White, \$1.00.
  - Best of Show is an honorary position.
12. Grand Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded in each Class IF THERE IS MERIT, and if there are more than six entries per Class; Classes with fewer entries will be combined by Class to the nearest age group, Professional entries will be combined in appropriate age class. Best of Show can be awarded to one piece from the entire show. This is the combined judges' choice.
13. Entries will be released between 7:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. on Sunday, July 28<sup>th</sup>. Make arrangements with the superintendent for family or friends to pick up for you if this time does not work for you. Entries not picked up during this designated time will not be awarded premiums and will be moved to the Fair Office until noon on Monday, July 30<sup>th</sup> and then taken to the Plymouth County Extension Office.
14. The Plymouth County Fair Board, Open Class Photography Show Superintendents and Plymouth County Extension Office are not responsible for damage or loss of exhibits.
15. If you are a Grand Champion Ribbon winner, pictures will be taken at 1:00 p.m. on Saturday July 27, in the Open Class Building.
