ENTRY FEE:

Early Bird Registration Fee: \$5.00 per animal (by **3/7/21**)
Late Registration Fee: \$10.00 per animal (**3/8/21** through Day of Show)
Showmanship \$5 (optional)

RULES & GUIDELINES

1. Entry forms with notarized hold harmless and entry fees must be turned in by 5:00 p.m., Monday, **March 7, 2022**, for early bird registrations (or postmarked by **Mar 7, 2022**). Registration forms may be turned in up to day of the show with the Late Registration Fee.
2. Showmanship class is optional. A \$5.00 Showmanship entry fee is required to enter the showmanship class.
3. Upon arrival all exhibitors must check in at the Tilton arena livestock office by **12:00 p.m.**, Animals not checked in by this time, will be considered "No Shows" and will be deleted from the Show.
4. Animals must be checked in at the Putnam County Fairgrounds between **11am-12pm** on Saturday, **March 19**, for Veterinary Inspection. A current health certificate, within 90 days, must be present at this time.
5. Animals not checked in during this time, will be considered "No Shows" and will be deleted from the Show.
6. All Animals must be participating in the scrapies eradication program and provide U.S.D.A. visit www.aphis.usda.gov or your local veterinarian for information.
7. Animals must be in acceptable condition, horns must be filed or dehorned, trained to be handled and led.
8. There will be NO body clipping of goats allowed at the show. However, you may do minor trimming, washing, grooming and fitting as necessary for show appearance.
9. Exhibitors must provide their own feed and water containers. Penning will be an open area where goats must be tied on a chain provided by owner.
10. Premium money and awards should be picked up before leaving the show. The Putnam County Fair will not be responsible for awards and premiums not picked up.
11. Exhibitors are to use the Back Entrance through main parking lot
12. Goat Exhibitor and one parent will be admitted free. All other helpers and family will be charged admission.

13. Grade or registered animals of Major breeds may be shown. **ONLY FEMALES MAY BE SHOWN.**
14. The Grand and Reserve Grand will be chosen from the winners of each Class.
15. The Putnam County Fair reserves the right to limit the number of entries. Exhibitor may only enter one animal per class.
16. In the Pee wee Class all exhibitors will receive a blue ribbon. This is a learning class so peewee exhibitors may have one helper in the ring.
17. Any and all rules, regulations and/or requirements are subject to change due to any federal, state and local government mandate. If such changes occur, a notification (or notifications) will be issued to agents, instructors, advisors and registered participants via the official registered contact information on file.
18. Exhibitor must wear the Fair issued armband with the assigned number to the animal being exhibited. **No harnesses may be worn.** Any exhibitor wearing a harness will be disqualified.

Class one	under 12 months of age (never freshened)
Class two	13 – 24 months of age
Class three	Milkers under 2 years of age
Class four	2 – 4 years of age
Class five	5 years and over

Meat Goats – Breeding Does

Class six	under 12 months of age
Class seven	13 – 24 months of age
Class eight	2 – 4 years of age
Class nine	5 years and over

Pee Wee Class (exhibitors ages 5-7) – exhibition only, all exhibitors will be given constructive critique and awarded a blue ribbon
