ENTRY DEADLINE: Sunday, March 19, 2023. @ 1:30 pm. Contest begins at 2 pm.

- 1. Contest is scheduled for Sunday, March 19, 2023, beginning at 2pm in the Arena.
- 2. Contestant **MUST** wear long pants and closed toed shoes to compete. Crocs are unacceptable.
- 3. Youth & Adult contestants will have 45 seconds to perform their whip cracking ability. Pee Wee will have 30 seconds.
- 4. Whips can be from 6 14 feet long.
- 5. In case of a tie, there will be a pop-off to determine the winner.
- 6. Judges will score on a scale of 1 10 (10 being highest score) based on most original, sharpness, loudness & best overall performance
- 7. **Contestant Conduct**: Any unbecoming behavior of contestant will be grounds for immediate disqualification and all awards, prizes and premiums will be forfeited.
- 8. Contestant will be disqualified if found cracking at ANY TIME other than in the Arena during the contest.
- 9. For **Whips & Tricks Division:** This category is for whips of shorter lengths than allowed in general competition, along with "tricks" that a participant may have.
 - o Routine is limited to 2 minutes.
 - o NO OTHER HUMANS OR ANIMALS will be allowed to assist in the trick unless they are dueling whip cracking partners. If assistance is needed to set up, that is allowed. For example: if a participant wants to demonstrate target cracking, a person/animal cannot stand holding said target.
