Two Calf Scrambles will be held in connection with the Show, one during the **Rodeo performance at 7:30 p.m. on Friday evening, March 18** and one during the **7:30 p.m. Rodeo performance on Saturday evening, March 19**. Scramblers who catch a calf will be awarded Purchase Certificates in the amount of \$800.00 to be applied to the purchase of a registered Beef Heifer, Commercial Heifer or a Market Steer.

A copy of the rules and other information pertaining to the Scramble are enclosed. We will accept **ONE CONTESTANT AND ONE ALTERNATE** from each FFA Chapter and 4-H Club. Contestants must be bonafide members of a 4-H club or FFA chapter in Cameron, Hidalgo, Willacy or Starr County and enrolled in elementary or secondary school at the time of the Show. The selection of the contestant and alternate will be left up to you. You may now enter your contestants online through our ShoWorks online entry system. The below application and waiver will still need to be turned in by the deadline date of January 14, 2022.

Please read the enclosed material carefully, then distribute a copy to the boy or girl and alternate you have chosen to participate. You will note the **deadline** for applications to be in our office is **January 14, 2022. ALL INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL BE RETURNED.**
