## COVER GIRL RULES

1. Each FFA Chapter and 4-H Club in Cameron, Hidalgo, Starr and Willacy counties will be allowed one contestant. Contestants must be a member of 4-H or FFA. No junior FFA Chapters will be eligible to enter a contestant.
2. A contestant must be under 18 years of age as of September 1, 2021
3. A contestant must be a junior in high school at the time of the contest in March. A contestant is only eligible to participate in the Cover Girl Contest once.
4. Any contestant who has attended school more than five semesters after the eighth grade, prior to September 1, 2021, is ineligible to participate.
5. A contestant must be single, never have been married and have no children at the time of the Show

6. A contestant must be a member of 4-H or FFA, must have a project entered in the 2022 Rio Grande Valley Livestock Show and must have had a least one other project in the Rio Grande Valley Livestock Show in previous years
7. Costumes of the contestants need not be elaborate or expensive. The main requirement of a costume is it be original in design and carry out a western theme.
8. Contestants, in addition to their costumes, will be judged on poise, beauty and personality
9. All contestants must attend the Cover Girl Orientation on Monday, January 3, 2022 to be eligible to compete
10. All contestants must attend the Cover Girl Rehearsal on Friday, March 4, 2022, to be eligible to compete
11. A Certification Form, provided by the Livestock Show, must be submitted by each contestant. The principal of the school, which the contestant attends, her parent/guardian and the Ag Teacher or 4-H Club Manager (of the Club/Chapter contestant is representing) must sign this form
12. Each contestant must furnish a portrait style 4"x6" photograph (head-shot) to be used for publicity purposes. PHOTOGRAPH MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY FORM. Keep in mind these photos will be used to judge "Miss Photogenic"
13. Each contestant must EMAIL a written biography to the RGVLS Livestock/Competitive Events Coordinator [terri@rgvls.com](mailto:terri@rgvls.com) by deadline. Biography must be a minimum of 185 words and cannot exceed a maximum of 200 words. The biography will serve as background information for when the contestant walks on stage
14. Deadline for entries and photographs will be Monday, December 17, 2021 by 5:00 p.m. A substitution for a contestant may be entered only by deadline, Monday, December 17, 2021
15. The contestant selected as Cover Girl will officiate at the 2023 Show and her picture will appear on the cover of the 2023 Rio Grande Valley Livestock Show Premium Book
16. Winners will be present at all required events as stipulated by the guidelines of the Rio Grande Valley Livestock Show. Failure to do so could result in relinquishment of title, scholarship award and disqualification of winner
17. The Executive Committee of the Livestock Show will have the privilege of determining the availability of the Cover Girl and/or runners up to represent the livestock show at any and all events
18. The Cover Girl will be asked to ride in parades at various times throughout the year. Should she be queen of another organizations, her first obligation will be to represent RGVLS
19. First, Second, Third and Fourth Runner up winners should be willing to participate in events at the 2022 Show when asked to do so.
20. Winners will be responsible for their own transportation to and from the Show grounds

21. Entry forms and pictures must be brought to the Livestock Show Office, 1000 N. Texas Mercedes, TX 78570 or sent by certified mail
